The central government has announced the division of labour for its newly appointed vice-premiers and state councillors, the *Southern Metropolis News* reported. Vice-Premier Li Keqiang will oversee overall economic and development planning, and will also assume Wen Jiabao's duties when the premier is overseas. Vice-Premier Wang Qishan is to take an expanded role in overseeing trade, tourism, product safety, customs and finance. He will be charged with pushing through the much-needed reforms for the financial sector. Vice-Premier Zhang Dejiang will be in charge of industry, telecommunication, energy and transport. Hui Liangyu retained his post as vice-premier in charge of agriculture. State Councillor Liu Yandong is to assist Vice-President Xi Jinping in handling Hong Kong and Macau affairs. She was also appointed as the first-rank vice-chairwoman of the Beijing Organising Committee for the Olympic Games (BOCOG). Taiwanese affairs were handed to State Councillor Dai Bingguo, the former vice-minister of foreign affairs. He will be in charge of foreign policy and diplomatic affairs. Ma Kai, the former chairman of the National Development and Reform Commission, is to oversee the day-to-day affairs of the General Office of the State Council. State Councillor Meng Jianzhu, minister of public security, will be responsible for internal security and law. Another state councillor is Defence Minister Liang Guanglie. (SCMP, 1 Apr 08)

HOHHOT, April 3 (Xinhua) – Bagatur, deputy Party secretary of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region, was approved acting chairman of the government of north China's Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region at the third plenary session of the region's 11th People's Congress Standing Committee. The 55-year-old ethnic Mongolian was also appointed vice-chairman of the regional government. The plenary session also accepted the resignation of Yang Jing, the previous chairman of the regional government. In November 2006 he was appointed first secretary of the CYL CC Secretariat. Hu is a member of the 17th CCP CC.

Chile (Apr 13)

SANYA, April 13 (Xinhua) - Chinese President Hu Jintao held official talks with Chilean President Michelle Bachelet Jeria, with the two leaders agreeing to promote bilateral all-round cooperative partnership to new heights. ... After their talks, the two leaders attended a signing ceremony of eight cooperative agreements between the two countries, including the service trade pact supplementary to the Sino-Chilean free trade agreement, the annual action plan for cultural exchanges, the protocol on the quarantine arrangements for some Chilean products to be exported to China. Kazakhstan (Apr 07)

The agreements mainly concerned cooperation in non-resource economy, finance, agriculture, electricity and hydropower. ... New Zealand (Apr 07)

BEIJING, April 7 (Xinhua) - China and New Zealand signed a free trade agreement, the first such pact between China and a developed country.

The deal was inked by Chinese Commerce Minister Chen Deming and New Zealand Trade Minister Phil Goff. Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao and his New Zealand counterpart Helen Clark attended the signing ceremony after over-one-hour bilateral talks.

The signing and implementation of the agreement will "further the friendly and cooperative relations between the two countries, promote each's economic growth, and bring practical benefits to the two peoples," Wen said at the beginning of the talks.

Wen described the day of the signing as "a day of historical significance" and said the move "met the goal" the two countries set during negotiations.

China and New Zealand formally launched the free trade negotiations in December 2004 and concluded the talks in December 2007 following 15 rounds of negotiations.

According to the agreement, all goods exported from China to New Zealand will be tariff free from January 1, 2016 while tariffs on most New Zealand exports to China will be eliminated from January 1, 2019.

Beyond trade in goods, the agreement covers the services sector, ranging from banking, environment, education and entertainment to construction and transportation.

The FTA calls for up to 1,800 Chinese people to enter New Zealand each year to work in areas such as traditional Chinese medicine, language teaching, Chinese martial art training, tourism, auditing and food service.

The FTA also sets up mechanisms for investment promotion and corporations in customs, quality inspection and quarantine, and the IPRs protection.

"The agreement will push forward bilateral comprehensive ties of cooperation to a higher level, open up new opportunities in trade and investment, and help both countries develop a more open, stable and competitive business environment," said Wang Xinpei, the Ministry of Commerce spokesman.

The pact not only facilitates the access of enterprises looking to the markets of China and New Zealand but also provide the consumers with cheaper and better products and services, Wang said.

The deal came after 15 rounds of negotiations over three years as the bilateral trade expanded year on year by 26 per cent to 3.7 billion US dollars in 2007.

The FTA agreement with China is the largest for New Zealand since the Closer Economic Agreement with Australia was signed in 1983. New Zealand is also the first developed country to recognize China's full market economy status.

Clark, accompanied by a 150-member trade delegation, arrived here on Sunday afternoon, starting an official visit to China as guest of Wen. (XNA, 7 Apr 08)

Pakistan (Apr 11)

Sanya, 11 April: President Pervez Musharraf and his Chinese counterpart Friday vowed to enhance cooperation in defence, energy and trade and hoped that these would be further

strengthened with the coming into power of a new government in Pakistan.

The talks here at China's southernmost city of Sanya covered a wide range of issues with a particular focus on Pak-China bilateral relations besides discussions on regional issues and international developments.

Following the round of formal talks, the two leaders also witnessed signing of two Memorandums of Understanding [MoU] and an agreement.

These included an MoU between the Ministries of Water and Power of the two countries, another on cooperation in sports and the third for cooperation in the area of engineering, sciences and technology. ... China is a major source of investment in Pakistan and was supporting the country in various sectors, particularly infrastructure development, energy, roads and dams and in this regard a Pakistan-China Joint Investment Company has been working since 2007.

Bilateral trade between the two countries has touched 6.8bn dollars. Pakistan and China signed a free trade pact in 2006 and hope to raise two-way trade to 15bn dollars within the next five years.

Pakistan-China Joint Five Year Economic Plan was signed in November 2006 and the Free Trade Agreement is operational since last year and has bolstered the economic cooperation between the two countries. ...

Pakistan was the first Islamic country to recognise People's Republic of China on 4 January 1950. Diplomatic relations were established between the two countries on 21 May 1951.

Tianjin has established sister city relations with 23 foreign cities, and entered friendly exchange and cooperation ties with more than 30 regions and cities worldwide, including Texas, Hawaii, Dallas and Houston.

Global leading telecom equipment producer Motorola whose headquarters is in Chicago has based its largest global mobile phone production base in Tianjin. As early as 1992, it built the Tianjin plant.
