Bosnia-Herzegovina (Sep 12)

Ghana (Sep 03)

President Kufuor witnessed the signing of seven agreements between Ghana and China. Ghana's Finance Minister Kwadwo Baah Wiredu and the Chinese deputy minister of commerce, Fu Ziying initialed for their countries.

Two agreements worth 7.4m dollars technical cooperation were signed. The projects for which these will be used are yet to be decided by both governments. The third is a concessional loan framework agreement of 270m dollars for the Bui Hydro Power Dam project between the governments of Ghana and China.

Another agreement worth 292m dollars was also signed for the same purpose but between the government of Ghana and the Exim Bank of China. This is the last phase of funding for the Bui Dam project. It was initiated last year [2007]. The government of Ghana is providing another component of 60m dollars. An agreement for eight point two million dollars for an ICT based distance learning programme at the University of Ghana was also signed.

China is also providing Ghana 250,000 dollars for Anti Malaria Drugs. This is the second time in two years that the Chinese government is making such a donation. The Exim Bank of China also signed with the government another concessional loan agreement for the based distance learning project at the University of Ghana. President Kufuor said the signing of the agreements should be in the interest of the two nations noting that the funds put together are well over a billion dollars and this is very significant. He said such cooperation should be sustained.

President Kufuor urged China to consider promoting trade in soya and palm oil. He said adding value in Ghana to soya and oil palm will promote growth and create employment for many Ghanaians. The Chinese deputy minister, Mr Fu Ziying observed that the signing of the seven agreements and exchange of letters have strengthened economic ties between the two countries. He hoped by these economic relations would have a brighter future. (Radio Ghana, Accra, 4 Sep 08, in BBC PF, 5 Sep 08)

North Korea (Sep 02)

Beijing, Sept. 2 (Xinhua) - China will allow its travel agencies to organize tour groups to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) as the Chinese government has decided to grant approved

destination status to the neighbouring country, China's National Tourism Administration (NTA) announced on 2 September.

Group tours to the DPRK will start "at an appropriate time after the two countries negotiate details and sign official agreements," a statement from the NTA quoted its deputy head Du Jiang as saying when he met his DPRK counterpart during a visit to the country on 29 August.

Du said 2009, the 60th anniversary of the establishment of Sino-DPRK diplomatic relations, would be a good opportunity for both countries to enhance cooperation in tourism, said Du.

"I believe China and the DPRK will further develop their relations and have closer cooperation," the statement quoted Du as saying.

Deputy Director Kang Chul-soo of the DPRK National Tourism Administration said the DPRK considered China as an important tourist source and hoped China could offer assistance in such fields as tourism promotion and personnel training.

Air China, the leading Chinese carrier, launched direct service from Beijing to Pyongyang in March. It is the only foreign airline to offer scheduled flights to the DPRK capital.

China approved 135 countries and regions as outbound destinations before the DPRK gained the status.

Chinese made 40.95 million outbound trips in 2007, more than any other Asian country and about 20 per cent up from the previous year. (XNA, 2 Sep 08)

Tajikistan (Aug 27)

Dushanbe, 27 Aug (Xinhua) - Chinese President Hu Jintao, who is currently on a state visit to Tajikistan, held talks with Tajik President Emomali Rakhmon. International Agreements

DUSHANBE, Aug. 28 (Xinhua) - Leaders of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) member states gathered in the Tajik capital for their annual summit, with the focus on security, economic and cultural cooperation within the bloc.

Chinese President Hu Jintao, Kazakh President Nursultan Nazarbayev, Kyrgyz President Kurmanbek Bakiyev, Russian President Dmitry Medvedev [Dmitriy Anatolyevich Medvedev], Tajik President Emomali Rakhmon [Emomali Rahmon] and Uzbek President Islam Karimov attended the summit.

Following the one-day summit, the heads of state inked a declaration and issued a joint communique.

They also witnessed the signing of several documents, including one on joint anti-terror drills, one on the crackdown on the smuggling of arms, ammunition and explosives, and a memorandum on bank cooperation.

In a keynote address to the summit, Chinese President Hu Jintao made a five-point proposal on developing lasting peace, common prosperity and regional harmony. ... Founded in Shanghai on June 15, 2001, the SCO groups China, Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. Mongolia, Pakistan, Iran and India are observers of the bloc. ... Hong Kong SAR Agreement with the Mainland (Aug 28)

HONG KONG, Aug. 28 (Xinhua) - Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) Chief Executive Donald Tsang signed a memorandum of understanding with head of the National Energy Administration Zhang Guobao, to confirm the continuous supply of nuclear power and natural gas to Hong Kong over the next two decades.

The agreement will relieve pressure for electricity tariff increases, the Chief Executive said.

It was also agreed the feasibility of supplying natural gas to Hong Kong via the second west-east natural gas pipeline will be studied, and the Chinese mainland government will build with Hong Kong a liquefied natural gas terminal on the mainland to supply natural gas to the city.

Speaking at the signing ceremony, Tsang said electricity generation is a major source of pollution in Hong Kong and the HKSAR government has been seeking the replacement of coal with cleaner fuels.

He said the sustained supply of clean energy from the Chinese mainland will reduce the need for Hong Kong to build a liquefied natural gas terminal. The resulting reduction in capital investment by the power company concerned will relieve the pressure for electricity tariff increases.

According to the memorandum, the quantity of electricity to be supplied by China Guangdong Nuclear Power Holding Company to Hong Kong in the next 20 years will be no less than the current level.

The China National Offshore Oil Corporation will supply natural gas to Hong Kong for another 20 years. (XNA, 28 Aug 08)
