



Interest rates and inflation

This note provides data on the interest rate decisions of the Bank of England's Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) and on the Consumer Prices Index (CPI) – the measure of inflation chosen as the Bank of England's inflation target.

This note is purely factual. It contains no analysis or discussion of monetary policy.

Key points:

- On 4 August, the Bank of England announced that interest rates would be kept on hold at 0.5%. Interest rates have been unchanged since March 2009. The next interest rate announcement will be on 8 September.
- With interest rates at such low levels, the focus of monetary policy has been on the Bank's measures to boost the money supply ("quantitative easing"). For more information, see the Bank's [website](#). A Library [note](#) on quantitative easing (SN/EP/4997) is also available.
- Inflation (measured by the change in the CPI) was 4.2% in June, down from 4.5% in May and above the Bank of England's 2% target for the nineteenth successive month. The next inflation figures (for July) are due to be published on 16 August.

1 Interest rates and inflation data

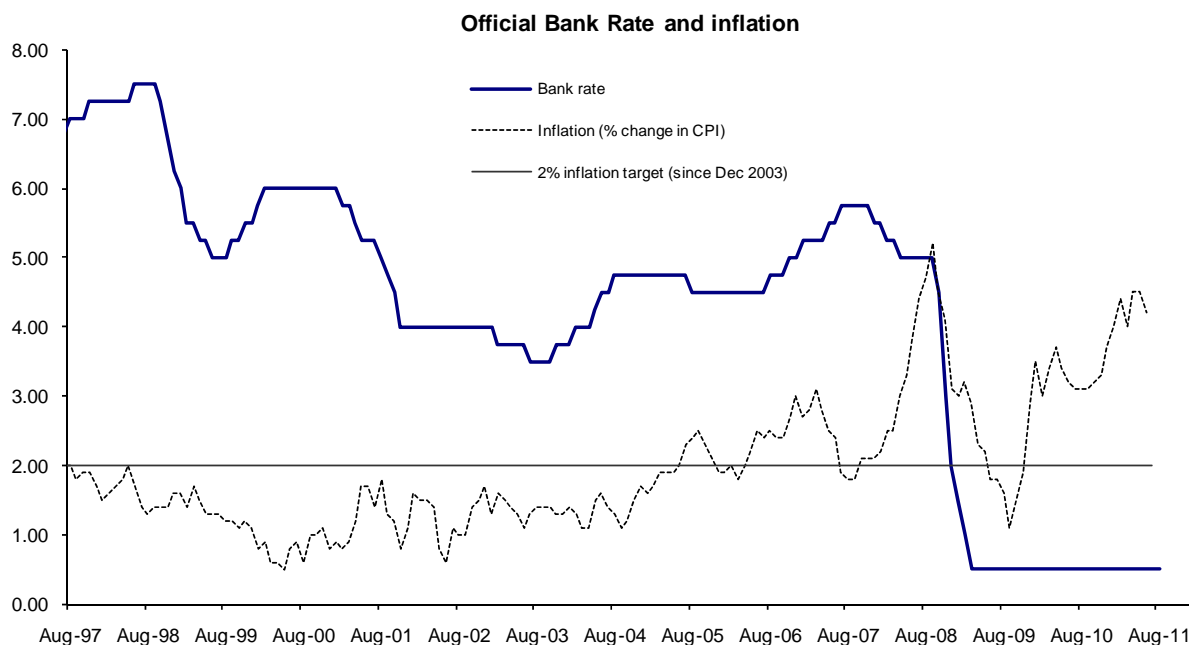
The table below shows inflation and the Bank of England's Official Bank Rate since the last rate change. The chart (and Appendix 1) shows the Bank Rate and inflation since May 1997. Inflation is measured by the 12 month change in the Consumer Prices Index (CPI), the measure used for the Bank's inflation target. Since December 2003, this has been 2%:
