### Ireland (Feb 23)

The Chinese and Irish ministries of education signed an agreement on mutual recognition of higher education degrees. The agreement will provide more convenient access for Chinese students with bachelor degrees to apply for master or PhD studies in Ireland, according to China's Ministry of Education. Chinese students will also have more access to information on Ireland's education system and its universities, according to the agreement. This agreement is of great importance to the promotion of cooperation between Ireland and China on education, said visiting Irish Minister of Education Mary Hanafin. About 3,000 Chinese students are currently studying in Ireland, according to official figures. (XNA, 23 Feb 06)

China and Pakistan on Monday [20 February] inked a series of agreements on wide-ranging topics, a sign of stronger ties between the two traditional allies. The agreements, which ranged from trade and energy to agriculture and defence, were signed after Chinese President Hu Jintao held talks with visiting Pakistani President Pervez Musharraf. Musharraf, who arrived here on Sunday for a five-day visit, on Monday strongly condemned the terrorist killing of three Chinese engineers in Pakistan last Wednesday, vowing to seize the culprits as soon as possible and mete out harsh punishment on them. Musharraf said earlier that Pakistan's friendship with China will "not be affected by the incident". In response, President Hu said that China "believes the Pakistani government will severely punish the criminals and take concrete measures to ensure the security of Chinese citizens and organizations in Pakistan". In the two-hour meeting on Monday afternoon, Hu and Musharraf reviewed the development of China-Pakistan ties, which Hu said are "all-weather" and "time-tested". The friendship serves as a "paradigm" of peaceful coexistence and sincere cooperation between countries of different social systems and cultures, Hu said. Echoing Hu's view, Musharraf said the Pakistani government and people take China as "a trustworthy neighbour and friend" and would like to carry on the bilateral friendship and step up the strategic cooperation. Musharraf's visit coincided with the 55th anniversary of diplomatic ties between the two neighbours. He will unveil a series of commemorative events in Beijing apart from meeting other senior Chinese leaders, including China's top legislator Wu Bangguo and Premier Wen Jiabao. "These important exchanges of visits of the leaders of the two countries have set the direction for further strengthening Pakistan-China relations in the 21st century," Pakistani Ambassador to China Salman Bashir said days ahead of Musharraf's China visit. According to the bilateral deals reached on Monday, China and Pakistan will step up collaboration on vocational training, pesticide cooperation and fisheries. The two countries will also work together on earthquake studies, meteorological science and family planning. Presi-

dent Hu suggested the two sides complete the ongoing projects and expand collaboration in fields such as energy, transportation, agriculture and infrastructure, which are all covered in Monday's agreements. The two sides also signed an agreement regarding the utilization of the preferential buyer's credit. Hu said he hoped the two sides could ratchet up the negotiation process, so as to set up the China-Pakistan free trade area as soon as possible. Moreover, Hu called for further cooperation on security and a joint crackdown on the "three forces" plaguing both countries, namely terrorism, separatism and extremism. ... (XNA, 20 Feb 06)

### Russia (Mar 02)

China and Russia will further their cooperation in fighting against cross-border crimes, illegal immigration and terrorism as well as enhancing law-enforcement, according to the Ministry of Public Security. Zhou Yongkang, Chinese state councillor and minister of public security, held talks with Russian Interior Minister Rashid Nurgaliyev in Beijing. Nurgaliyev is here to attend a meeting on law-enforcement between the Chinese Ministry of Public Security and the Russian Interior Ministry. The two sides said the meeting could play a role in maintaining social stability and safeguarding people's lives and possessions. After the talks, the two ministers signed an agreement on setting up a joint taskforce to crack down on cross-border crimes. (XNA, 2 Mar 06)

### International Agreements

#### Macau SAR Agreement with Greece (Feb 17)

Representatives from the aeronautical authorities of the Macau SAR and the Hellenic Republic of Greece met in Macau ... initialed the Air Services Agreement and signed the respective Memorandum of Understanding. According to the provisions of the agreement and the MoU, the two parties exchange various traffic rights ... The signatories were the Acting President of the Civil Aviation Authority of Macau SAR, Mr. Chan Weng Hong and the Director General, the Directorate General of Air Transport, Civil Aviation Authority of the Hellenic Re-

public of Greece, Mrs. Fotini Mitakou. In addition to civil aviation officials, the Consul General of Greece in Hong Kong also participated in the meeting. Representatives of CAM-Macau International Airport Company Limited and Air Macau attended the meeting as observers. The agreement established the framework for the scheduled air services between the two places and enhanced the mutual relationship. Up till this present moment, Macao has initialed 44 air services agreements with other foreign countries. Out of these agreements, 36 have been officially signed. #### **Macau SAR Agreement with the Mainland (Feb 28)**

Mainland civil court rulings will soon be enforceable in Macau - and vice versa - after the MSAR struck a long-awaited agreement with judicial authorities in Beijing. The agreement, which will take effect on April 1, is expected to greatly speed up the settlement of civil and commercial disputes between the mainland and Macau. A similar agreement between the mainland and Hong Kong has yet to be signed. The deal with Macau will cover rulings in all civil and commercial cases, including labour disputes and compensation judgments made in criminal courts. Macau Bar Association Secretary-General Paulino Comandante said the deal would provide a boost to plaintiffs and serve as a deterrent to debtors. Until the agreement takes effect, it is possible to have a mainland judgment enforced in Macau, but not vice versa. "It normally takes six months to one year for a mainland plaintiff [who has won a case on the mainland] to seek a new judgment in Macau," said Mr Comandante. The time-consuming process of seeking a second judgment will become unnecessary under the new agreement. "The need for cross-border enforcement is rising, as residents from both jurisdictions engage in closer social and economic contacts," he said. "The agreement will provide some protection for cross-border investors who otherwise may find it frustrating to settle disputes through litigation." ... (SCMP, 1 Mar 06)

## PRC Laws and Regulations

The **Decision of the NPC Standing Committee on Amendments of the "PRC Audit Law"** has been approved by the 20th meeting of the 10th NPC Standing Committee on 28 February 2006, and is hereby promulgated for implementation beginning from 1 June 2006. (Presidential Decree No. 48, signed by State President Hu Jintao on 28 February 2006) (Full text: RMRB, 1 Mar 06)

The revised Audit Law ... requires the government officials to be audited during his or her tenure to ensure efficient use of public funds and prevent corruption. ... The revised Audit Law added a new clause, saying auditors are entitled to audit leading officials of departments under the central government and leading officials in local governments. ... The revised law also said Chinese auditors are entitled to request organizations provide electronic account balances and ensure the integrity and authenticity of the financial statements, in a bid to effectively supervise audit organizations and prevent the concealment of important financial information. ... If auditors ever receive reports that an official has public funds in a personal bank account, auditors will be entitled to launch an investigation with only the approval of leading officials at the county-level or above, according to the revised law. **Audit Law of the People's Republic of China.** (Adopted at the 9th meeting of the 8th NPC Standing Committee on 31 August 1994, and revised according to the "Decision of the NPC Standing Committee on Amendments of the 'PRC Audit Law'" at the 20th meeting of the 10th NPC Standing Committee on 28 February 2006. **AIDS Prevention and Control Regulations,** adopted at the State Council's 122nd executive meeting on 18 January 2006. These regulations will take effect as of 1 March 2006. (State Council Decree No 458 of the People's Republic of China, signed by Premier Wen Jiabao on 29 January 2006) (Full text: RMRB, 13 Jan 06; full translation: Xinhua, 12 Feb 06, in BBC PF, 19 Mar 06) The regulations consist of seven chapters with 64 articles.

**Provisions of the State Council on Levying of Taxes on Income from Agricultural Specialities,** promulgated as Decree No.143 of the State Council of the PRC on January 30, 1994, will be rescinded as of 17 February 2006. (State Council Decree No 459 of the People's Republic of China, signed by Premier Wen Jiabao on 17 February 2006) (RMRB, 25 Feb 06)

**Regulations on the Approval of Water Use and the Levying of Management Charge on Water Resources,** adopted at the State Council's 123rd Standing Conference on 24 January 2006. These regulations will go into effect on 15 April 2006. (State Council Decree No 460 of the People's Republic of China, signed by Premier Wen Jiabao on 21 February 2006) The regulations consist of seven chapters with 58 articles. (XNA, 6 Mar 06; full text: RMRB, 8 Mar 06)

**Decision of the State Council on Amending the "Provisions on Administrative Penalty for Law-Breaking Behaviour in Pricing"**. The decision will be effective from 1 May 2006. (State Council Decree No 461 of the People's Republic of China, signed by Premier Wen Jiabao on 21

February 2006) (Full text of the decision: RMRB, 11 Mar 06)

**Provisions on Administrative Penalty for Law-Breaking Behaviour in Pricing.** (Approved by the State Council on 10 July 1999, promulgated by the State Development Planning Commission on 1 August 1999, and revised according to the "Decision of the State Council on Amending the 'Provisions on Administrative Penalty for Law-Breaking Behaviour in Pricing'" on 21 February 2006) The provisions consist of 20 articles. (Full text of the provisions: RMRB, 11 Mar 06)

**Details for Implementing the Provisional Regulations on Administering the Registration of Institutions** (State Bureau for Administering the Registration of Institutions, 15 April 2005). The detailed rules consist of nine chapters with 86 articles and will go into effect as of 1 January 2006. (Full text: RMRB, 20 Feb 06)

**Interim Provisions on Party Member-Leading Cadres' Report on Work and Clean Handling of Duty.** The provisions consist of 13 articles and will become effective on the day of promulgation. (Full text: RMRB, 27 Feb 06; full translation: Xinhua, 26 Feb 06, in BBC PF, 28 Feb 06)

**Interim Methods for Conducting Admonitions and Correspondence Inquiries with Party Members and Leading Cadres.** The methods consist of 15 articles and will become effective on the day of promulgation. (Full text: RMRB, 27 Feb 06; full translation: Xinhua, 26 Feb 06, in BBC PF, 15 Mar 06)

In an effort to ban abuse of prisoners, China's justice authority is warning police and prison guards that they can be fired for torturing inmates or taking bribes. **New regulations governing police conduct** issued by the Ministry of Justice, focus on inmate torture, irregular use of weapons and police vans, accepting bribes from inmates or their families, on-duty drinking, and gambling. Fan Fangping, vice-minister of justice, said the regulations are aimed at improving law enforcement and raising the standards of Chinese police and prison guards.

Fan said that while the overall performance of police and guards is good, there are some cops who "feel superior to inmates and act rudely". He said the regulations have been distributed to all of the country's prisons and hopes they will be observed by all law enforcement personnel. "Anyone who violates the ban on abuse will be disciplined," Fan said, adding that severe violations will lead to firing and warns that superiors who cover up abuses will also face discipline. China has two laws to regulate police behaviour - the Prison Law, enacted in 1994, and the Law on People's Police, enacted in 1995. They prohibit abuse of inmates and extorting a confession through torture. (XNA, 20 Feb 06)

**Regulations to punish officials for environmental damage.** The Chinese government on 20 February issued a set of regulations aiming to punish government officials for their malpractice or corruption which has resulted in environmental damage to the country. "The move is a major step taken to enforce environment-related laws and help officials heighten their sense of responsibility in protecting the environment," said Li Yufu, vice-minister of supervision, at a press conference. The set of regulations, consisting of 16 articles, spells out a series of penalties ranging from disciplinary warnings to expulsion from public employment, and also applies to government-appointed officials in enterprises. China stepped up law enforcement in the environment sector in the wake of the major Songhua River pollution in November last year, which affected water supplies for millions of people living in both China and neighbouring Russia. Soon after the disaster, Director of the State Environmental Protection Administration (SEPA) Xie Zhenhua was dismissed and a number of officials were punished. "The environmental status in China is still very severe, and human factors contribute much to the situation," said Li. Many localities pursue economic growth at the cost of the environment and even formulate "local regulations" to block enforcement of environment-related laws, he said. The officials who were found to be responsible for environmental damage often go unpunished due to the lack of specific regulations targeting them,

he said. According to the newly-issued regulations, the officials who fail to order enterprises which cause widespread pollution to stop production or close down will be disciplined or even dismissed from their post. And the officials who fail to report or fabricate reports after major environmental incidents will also be severely punished. "The implementation of the regulations marks a turning point for environment-related law enforcement in China," said SEPA Deputy Director Zhu Guangyao. He disclosed that SEPA and the Ministry of Supervision will soon jointly publicize a list of heavy polluters and will directly supervise their rectification. (XNA, 20 Feb 06)

**A new regulation on intellectual property rights (IPR) protection for exhibits** comes into effect as of 1 March. The regulation was jointly issued by the Ministry of Commerce, the State Administration for Industry and Commerce, the National Copyright Administration, and the State Intellectual Property Office. According to the regulation, exhibition organizers have to strengthen the protection and auditing of IPR protection of exhibits. An office should be established by exhibition organizers to handle complaints about IPR infringement if an exhibition is to be held for over three days, the regulation said. The regulation also requires corresponding departments to accept and hear cases involving IPR infringement, including those for patents, trademarks and copyrights. Those exhibition organizers and participants infringing IPR may be prohibited from holding or joining exhibitions again. In January this year, about 1,000 organizations in China's exhibition industry jointly signed a declaration, promising to rule out any IPR infringement in their exhibitions. (XNA, 1 Mar 06)
