Angola (Jun 20)

Wen Jiabao, premier of the State Council, held talks with Angolan President Jose Eduardo dos Santos in Luanda on 20 June. ... After the talks, the two leaders attended the ceremony for the signing of the treaty on extradition between China and Angola, the China-Angola economic and technological cooperation agreement, and other bilateral cooperation agreements. The two countries also issued a joint communique. (Xinhua, 21 Jun 06, in BBC PF, 22 Jun 06) ... The two sides signed a number of agreements and legal documents on bilateral cooperation in the economic, technological, judicial, health and agricultural fields. They also agreed to strengthen consultations on major international and regional issues in order to safeguard common interests and promote peace, stability and development. Under an agreement, Angola will set up a consulate general in the Macau Special Administrative Region of China. ... (XNA, 21 Jun 06)

Australia (Jul 13)

China and Australia agreed to extend two cooperation projects on HIV/AIDS prevention and environmental rehabilitation. Under the agreement signed by Vice-Minister

Yi Xiaozhun for China's Ministry of Commerce and Australian Ambassador to China Alan Thomas, the Australian government will provide China with 2.85m Australian dollars (2.15m US\$) in aid. Of the total, 2.2m Australian dollars will go to the Asia Regional HIV/AIDS Project and will be used to reduce HIV infection caused by contaminated needle use in southwest China's Yunnan Province and Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region. The remaining 650,000 Australian dollars will finance the Alxa League Environmental Rehabilitation and Management Project in north China's Inner Mongolia, which started in June 2001 and has already been given 10.35m Australian dollars in aid. Both sides also agreed to extend the two projects for one more year. The two projects were funded by the Australian government's overseas aid programme through Australian Development Aid. (XNA, 13 Jul 06)

Denmark (Jun 09)

The Danish government is to grant the Chinese government 6m euros in aid for the development of wind power in northeast China. Under an agreement signed by Chinese Vice-Minister of Commerce Yi Xiaozhun and Danish Ambassador to China Laurids Mikaelson, the aid will finance wind power generation projects in Heilongjiang, Liaoning and Jilin Provinces. With a wind power generation capacity of 3,122 mW, Denmark leads the world in manufacturing wind-driven generators, evaluating resources and producing pneumatic conveyors. The project to be completed in four years is aimed at improving China's capability of wind power generation and to facilitate bilateral exchanges of wind power technologies, according to sources with the Ministry of Commerce. To ease China's energy shortage, the State Development and Reform Commission mapped out a plan to spur investment and technological innovation in wind power earlier this year. Under the plan, China's wind power capacity is expected to hit 20m kW by 2020. Last year, the figure stood at 1.266m kW. (XNA, 9 Jun 06)

Egypt (Jun 17)

Visiting Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao held talks with Egyptian Prime Minister Ahmad Nazif in Cairo to dis-

cuss means to deepen bilateral strategic and cooperative relations. Following the talks, the two leaders attended a signing ceremony for 11 accords covering political, economic, cultural and educational aspects. Of the accords, Wen and Nazif signed "The Implementary Outlines for Deepening the Strategic Cooperative Relations between the People's Republic of China and the Arab Republic of Egypt". Chinese Foreign Minister Li Zhaoxing and his Egyptian counterpart Ahmad Abu-al-Ghayt signed an agreement between the two governments on mutual exemption from visa for Chinese diplomatic and service passport holders and for Egyptian diplomatic and special passport holders. Chinese Minister of Commerce Bo Xilai and Egyptian Minister of International Cooperation Fayizah Abu-al-Naja inked three agreements, namely, an agreement on economic and technological cooperation, a framework agreement on preferential loan from China to Egypt and a MOU between the two governments on building a rural primary school in Egypt. After the signing ceremony, Wen and Nazif attended a ceremony to inaugurate several cooperative projects in Egypt, including an investors' building featuring one-stop service, a phosphate project in New Valley, and a project of rehabilitation of Cairo International Conference Centre and construction of a five-star affiliated hotel. ... Egypt is the first leg of Wen's seven-nation visit to Africa, which will also take him to Ghana, the Republic of Congo, Angola, South Africa, Tanzania and Uganda. (XNA, 17 Jun 06)

Ghana (Jun 18)

Visiting Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao met Ghanaian President John Agyekum Kufuor in Accra, exchanging views on further promoting the traditional bilateral friendship, expanding mutual beneficial cooperation and other issues of common concern. They also signed documents on cooperation in economic development, trade, education and health. ... (XNA, 18 Jun 06) Ghana and China have signed various agreements to accelerate the socio-economic development and also consolidate the ever-growing friendship between the two countries. This was after bilateral talks at the Castle led by President

Kufuor and the Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao. They include an interest free loan of 4m dollars for economic and technical cooperation in areas to be agreed on by the two countries. An agreement for the provision of a concessional loan of about 30m dollars for the National Communications Backbone project was signed. A memorandum of understanding was also signed for the construction of rural primary schools and the establishment of a Malaria Prophylactic Therapeutic Demonstration Centre. Notes were exchanged in respect of a donation of about 25m dollars for the supply of anti-malaria drugs. (Radio Ghana, Accra, 19 Jun 06, in BBC PF, 20 Jun 06)

Guinea Bissau (Jun 28)

China and Guinea Bissau signed an agreement to beef up the two country's cooperation in agriculture, according to reports from Bissau, the African country's capital. The agreement, signed in Bissau by China's Ambassador to Guinea Bissau Tian Guangfeng and the African nation's Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development Sola N'Quilin Na Bitchita, committed China to help Guinea Bissau mainly in planting rice. According to the agreement, China will send 15 agricultural experts to Guinea Bissau to give training lessons in rice planting technologies, and the presentation and promotion of super rice seeds. China will also provide Guinea Bissau with agricultural materials such as agricultural machines and spare parts, seeds, fertilizer and pesticides. (XNA, 29 Jun 06)

Indonesia (Jun 23)

Surabaya, Indonesia's second largest city, and Xiamen, capital of China's southern province of Fujian, agreed to unite in a sister-city relationships. The Memorandum of Understanding on sister-city relationship was signed into effect by Surabaya Mayor Bambang Dwi Hartono and Xiamen Political Consultative Conference Chairman Chen Xiumao in Surabaya. Under the agreement, the two cities will promote closer cooperation in a wide range of areas, from trade, tourism, education, science, to technology. "We do hope that the agreement will bring advantages to Surabaya as there are many sectors we can develop together with Xiamen, such as trade and

tourism," Bambang said after signing the agreement. Chen, who led an eight-member delegation to the event, said "Surabaya and Xiamen have a lot in common. Surabaya has, among others, its own port and an institute of technology like we do." After Guangzhou, capital of Guangdong province, Xiamen is the second Chinese city with which Surabaya establishes a sister-city relationship. (XNA, 23 Jun 06)

Japan (Jun 23)

... Chinese Vice-Minister of Foreign Affairs Wu Dawei and Japanese Ambassador to China Yuji Miyamoto signed a document on Japanese yen loans to China in the financial year of 2005. In March, the Japanese government froze the annual disbursement of loans to China for the fiscal year 2005. But earlier this month, the Japanese government decided to unfreeze the aid. The 74.798bn-yen loans will be used in 10 projects in China, involving environment protection, human resource development and education, according to the Foreign Ministry. (XNA, 23 Jun 06)

South Korea (Jun 16)

China and the Republic of Korea reached agreement on drastically expanding civil aviation services between the two countries, the General Administration of Civil Aviation of China said on its website. According to a memorandum of understanding signed by the two sides at the end of their three days negotiations in Weihai, a coastal city in East China's Shandong Province, passengers flights between the two countries will be increased by 197 flights per week to reach 401 per week, and cargo flights by 12 flights to reach 36 flights per week. The agreement adds six Chinese cities, namely, Yanji, Shenzhen, Hefei, Zhengzhou, Changsha and Weihai as destinations. It allows airlines from both sides to determine their flight number and capacity input on routes from or to Chinese cities, namely Jinan, Qingdao, Yantai and Weihai according to market needs. Chinese airlines are allowed to increase their flights to Cheju in ROK if market need arises. Aviation services between China and ROK have expanded quickly since the two countries signed their first civil aviation agreement in 1994. China is

the second largest aviation market for ROK and vice versa. According to official figures, 10 Chinese and ROK airlines transported 6.35 million passengers and 300,000 tons of goods on 42 routes. It is believed that the new agreement will raise bilateral aviation cooperation to a new level and help further boost bilateral relations. (XNA, 17 Jun 06)

Kyrgyzstan (Jun 09)

Kyrgyz President Kurmanbek Bakiyev has met Chinese President Hu Jintao during his state visit to China. ... On the results of the Kyrgyz-Chinese talks on 9 June, 14 cooperation agreements were signed in the spheres of economy, education, and scientific and technical exchange. (Kabar news agency, Bishkek, 9 Jun 06, in BBC PF, 10 Jun 06) Following talks, Kyrgyz President Kurmanbek Bakiyev and Chinese President Hu Jintao signed a joint declaration and an agreement on technical and economic cooperation, the Kyrgyz president's press service says. The two sides also signed agreements on cooperation in the spheres of culture, sports, agriculture, health care, education, protection of intellectual property and the archive business. Kyrgyzstan and China also signed a general contract to construct a cement factory in Kyzyl-Kiya (Batken Region of Kyrgyzstan). ... (24.kg website, Bishkek, 9 Jun 06, in BBC PF, 10 Jun 06)

Laos (Jun 30)

China is to provide neighbouring Laos with a package of assistance covering agricultural machinery, finance and training under an agreement signed by the two countries in Beijing. The agreement was announced in a joint communique on the week-long state visit by general secretary of the Central Committee of the Lao People's Revolutionary Party and Lao President Choummali Sai-Gnason, a guest of Chinese President Hu Jintao. "Both sides agreed to further cooperation in the fields of economy and trade, electric power, minerals, agriculture and tourism," says the communique. "Both countries will support and encourage two-way investment of their enterprises and expand trade in border areas." The two sides exchanged notes on China's provision of agricultural machinery to Laos and on the

provision of training for Lao government officials. ... (XNA, 30 Jun 06)

Montenegro (Jul 06) Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao met in Beijing on 7 July with visiting Montenegrin Foreign Minister Miodrag Vlahovic. China and Montenegro on 6 July inked a joint communique to establish diplomatic ties. (XNA, 7 Jul 06) China and Montenegro inked a joint communique to establish diplomatic ties. "The establishment of China-Montenegro diplomatic ties is a significant event in the history of bilateral relations," said Chinese Foreign Minister Li Zhaoxing, following the signing of the joint communique by Li and his Montenegro's counterpart Miodrag Vlahovic. China and Montenegro, in keeping with the interests and desire of the two peoples, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at the ambassadorial level as from July 2006, the communique says. The Chinese government announced its recognition of Montenegro's sovereignty and independence on 14 June this year. Montenegro was admitted as the 192nd member of the United Nations on 28 June. Montenegrin parliament Speaker Ranko Krivokapic declared the independence of Montenegro on 3 June after the parliament ratified the result of the independence referendum held on 21 May. The declaration ended Montenegro's long-time union with Serbia since 1918. (XNA, 6 Jul 06) China inaugurated its embassy in Podgorica, capital of Montenegro, on 7 July, a day after the two countries signed in Beijing a joint communique to establish diplomatic ties. The fully-fledged embassy has replaced the country's general consulate and previous general consul Liu Wenxin will be chargé d'affaires. Liu told Xinhua that China was the second country to open an embassy in Montenegro, only after Slovenia. ... (XNA, 7 Jul 06)

Pakistan (Jul 10)

Pakistan and China have signed an agreement for reconstruction and upgradation of Karakoram Highway. About 350 kilometre road between Raikot bridge and Khanjrab pass will be reconstructed and repaired in first phase. According to the agreement, Chinese Road and Bridge Corporation will be responsible for design and reconstruction of the highway. It may

be recalled that the Karakoram Highway was badly damaged due to earthquake. (Associated Press of Pakistan news agency, Islamabad, 10 Jul 06, in BBC PF, 11 Jul 06)

Senegal (Jun 22)

Chinese President Hu Jintao pledged to further improve China-Senegal relations while talking with his Senegalese counterpart Abdoulaye Wade. "The resumption of diplomatic relations between China and Senegal last October turns over a new leaf in bilateral relations," said Hu. China and Senegal resumed diplomatic relations at the ambassadorial level on 25 October, China severed its ties with Senegal in 1996 after Dakar "recognized" the island of Taiwan. ... (XNA, 22 Jun 06) ... After the talks, the two heads of state attended the ceremony for the signing of cooperation documents, among which is the China-Senegal Agreement on Economic and Technological Cooperation. ... (Xinhua, 22 Jun 06, in BBC PF, 24 Jun 06)

South Africa (Jun 21)

China and South Africa signed 13 agreements on cooperation in a wide range of fields such as politics, economy, trade, national defence, agriculture, technology and sciences. What most important [as received] is the pact on deepening strategic partnership between the two developing giants which was signed by visiting Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao and South African President Thabo Mbeki. The Chinese premier announced that China will give 20m RMBY (about 2.5m US\$) assistance to South Africa in offering and training various skills. ... (XNA, 21 Jun 06)

Tanzania (Jun 22)

... After the talks ended, State Council Premier Wen Jiabao and Tanzanian President Kikwete both attended the signing ceremony for some bilateral cooperation documents, including an agreement on economic and technological cooperation between the two governments. The two countries also published a joint communique. ... (Xinhua, 23 Jun 06, in BBC PF, 24 Jun 06) Tanzania on 23 June signed a loan agreement of about 80m yuan [10m dollars] from the Chinese government to assist in the implementation of different projects in the country.

The statement made available from the State House said that the minister for foreign affairs and international cooperation signed on behalf of the government of Tanzania and China's Minister for Trade Bo Xilai signed on behalf of his government. The statement said China has also given the governments of Tanzania and Zambia an interest free loan totalling 50m yuan for the development of Tanzania-Zambia Railway Authority (Tazara). The decision to offer affordable loans to Tanzania was made by the Chinese Prime Minister Wen Jiabao during his visit in the country and followed talks with President Kikwete at the State House yesterday. "We would also like to build a modern centre to offer agricultural training. We would also give experts to train Tanzanian experts in the agricultural field. We will also build a centre for prevention and treatment of malaria and offer malaria drugs worth 3m yuan," [Wen] Jiabao said. In their agreement, China has also said it will build a modern primary school at any selected village in the country. Concerning the construction of the new stadium, the Chinese PM clarified that it was the second largest project funded by Chinese in the county after Tazara. President Kikwete, on his part, said many Tanzanians have been losing their lives because of lack of treatment of malaria and heart diseases. China has also scrapped tax for Tanzania goods being imported in China. (The Guardian website, Dar es Salaam, 24 Jun 06, in BBC PF, 25 Jun 06)

Uganda (Jun 23)

China signed six agreements with Uganda in a wide range of fields including economy, trade, agriculture, education and technology. After a talk between Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao and Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni, Chinese Commerce Minister Bo Xilai and Ugandan Finance Minister Ezra Suruma signed the agreements. ... After the talks, Wen Jiabao and President Museveni jointly attended the signing ceremony for the economic and technological cooperative agreement between the two governments and other bilateral cooperative documents, which state that the Chinese side will provide Uganda with malaria medicines and build an agricultural demonstration centre and vil-

lage schools in Uganda. The two countries have also issued a joint communique. ... (Xinhua, 24 Jun 06, in BBC PF, 25 Jun 06)

International Agreements

Shanghai Cooperation Organization [SCO] member countries on 15 June signed 10 documents on information security, anti-terrorism, economic and financial cooperation at a summit meeting in Shanghai. The documents include a declaration on the fifth anniversary of the SCO founding, a statement on international information security, a resolution on SCO secretary-general and another on the secretariat, a resolution on fighting terrorism, separatism and extremism from 2007 to 2009, an agreement on joint anti-terrorism actions among member countries, and an agreement on cutting off the infiltration channels of terrorists, separatists and extremists. In addition, there are an agreement on inter-governmental education cooperation, a resolution on the SCO Entrepreneurs' Committee, and an action guideline for the SCO banks consortium. The SCO is an intergovernmental organization founded in Shanghai on 15 June, 2001, by China, Russia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. (XNA, 15 Jun 06)

China, Singapore and Sri Lanka signed the United Nations Convention on the Use of Electronic Communications in International Contracts on 6 July. The three countries joined the Central African Republic, Lebanon and Senegal as signatories. The Convention was prepared by the UN Commission on International Trade Law, and adopted by the General Assembly last November. As the core legal body of the UN system in the field of international trade law, the convention is aimed to enhance legal certainty and commercial predictability where electronic communications are used in international contracts. The convention also contains rules on how to locate a party in an electronic environment, and on how to determine the time and place of dispatch and receipt of electronic communications. Hong Kong SAR and Macau SAR Agreement with Mainland China (Jun 29)

Health authorities of Guangdong, Macau and Hong Kong signed an agreement to strengthen co-operation in fighting infectious diseases. The agreement was reached at the sixth tripartite meeting of the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macau Expert Group on the Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases. It was held in Dongguan on 28 and 29 June. Participants included more than 60 public health and medical experts. (SCMP, 29 Jun 06)

Hong Kong SAR Agreement with Mainland China (Jun 27)

The Ministry of Commerce and the HKSAR government have signed the third supplementary agreement of the Mainland/Hong Kong Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (CEPA), a senior official with the Ministry of Commerce announced in Hong Kong on 29 June. Approved by the State Council, Vice-Minister of Commerce Liao Xiaoqi and Hong Kong Financial Secretary Henry Tang signed the agreement on behalf of the central government and the HKSAR government, respectively, on 27 June. According to the third supplementary agreement of CEPA, the Chinese mainland will further open its services and trade sectors to Hong Kong and strengthen its cooperation with Hong Kong in trade and investment facilitation. As for further cooperation in the services and trade fields to be in operation as of 1 January, 2007, the Chinese mainland will take additional 15 measures for further opening to Hong Kong in fields of law, exhibition and convention, information technology, audio-visual, construction, distribution, tourism, transportation and self-employed business. The new measures include relaxing of restrictions on shareholding, lowering capital levels for ventures' registration and some other conditions for registration and widening regions or management scopes. The two sides also decided to list the intellectual property protection in CEPA's trade and investment facilitation fields and will further explore ways for cooperation, in a bid to introduce Hong Kong's experiences in intellectual property protection, help

mainland's work and strengthen bilateral cooperation in this regard. Since its signing three years ago, CEPA has been implemented smoothly, with common efforts of people from all walks of life in the mainland and Hong Kong. The Chinese mainland has pledged to honour the commitments to CEPA and raise the level of cooperation between the two sides and push ahead with common development of prosperity of both the mainland and Hong Kong. Macau SAR Agreement with Mainland China (Jun 26)

With the signing of a supplementary agreement of the Mainland/Macau Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (CEPA), the Chinese mainland will further open its services and trade sectors to Macau, a senior official with the Ministry of Commerce said on 29 June. Vice-Minister of Commerce Liao Xiaoqi and Tam Pak Yuen, secretary for economy and finance of the Macau SAR, signed the third supplementary agreement of the Mainland/Macau Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (CEPA) on 26 June, said the official attending a Forum on Economic and Trade Cooperation and Development Between the Mainland, Hong Kong and Macau which was held in Hong Kong on 29 June. According to the supplementary agreement to be in operation as of 1 January, 2007, the Chinese mainland will take 13 new measures for further opening to Macau in such sectors as law, construction, exhibition, audio-visual, distribution, tourism, transportation and self-employed business. The measures include relaxation of share-holding restrictions, lowering threshold like registration capital and other conditions for registration, and widening business scope and area, and relaxing the conditions for natural person flow. In the sphere of trade and investment facilitation, the two sides have decided to include cooperation in convention and exhibition business in their original cooperation range. The two sides have also decided to list the cooperation in the intellectual property protection in the CEPA framework. Since its signing some three years ago, CEPA has been implemented smoothly and generated fruitful results, said the official. The

official said the Chinese mainland has pledged to further implement the measures it committed in CEPA in the future and raise the level of co-operation between the two sides and push forward the prosperity of both the mainland and Macau. The Chinese mainland and Macau signed the CEPA in October 2003. (XNA, 29 Jun 06)

The Secretary for Economy and Finance, Mr Francis Tam Pak Yuen, said on 29 June that the new supplement to the Mainland and Macau Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (CEPA) would benefit the streamlining and diversification of Macau's economic structure. After attending the opening ceremony of the "Mainland, Hong Kong and Macau Trade and Economic Co-operation Forum" in Hong Kong on 29 June, Mr Tam said that Supplement III to CEPA, signed on Monday (26 June), had provided enhanced conditions in three areas, namely the "trade in goods", the "trade in services", and the "trade and investment facilitation". In "trade in services", relaxed measures are given to Macau enterprises and professionals from services sectors such as legal, construction, audiovisual, distribution, tourism, transport, individually owned stores, convention and exhibition, when entering the markets in the Mainland. Speaking on State Council's approval of a round-the-clock and special-purpose checkpoint in the soon-to-be-completed Zhuhai-Macau Trans-border Industrial Park, Mr Tam said that it would greatly benefit the development of the industrial zone. He but added that people with business connections with companies in the park would be only allowed to use this checkpoint: others would continue to use the present facilities. Macau SAR Agreement with Mongolia (Jun 27)

Macau and Mongolia signed an aviation agreement on 27 June to further promote bilateral exchanges. The Secretary for Transportation and Public Works, Mr Ao Man Long, and the Minister of Road, Transportation and Tourism of Mongolia, Mr Tsegmidiin Tsengel, signed the agreement in Ulaanbaatar on behalf of the two

governments. Mr Ao, who was on a visit to Mongolia, said the agreement marked the beginning of co-operation between the two places, and aviation ties would further enhance their relationship in tourism and trade. The latest agreement with Mongolia is Macau's 39th international aviation protocol. (Government Information Office of the MSAR, web site, 28 Jun 06, accessed 5 Jul 06)

Macau SAR Agreement with Portugal (Jun 23)

The Macau Special Administrative Region (MSAR) of China and Portugal signed an agreement in Lisbon on granting tax immunity to each other's resident representatives. The agreement was signed by visiting MSAR Chief Executive Edmund Ho Hao Wah and Portuguese Minister of State and Foreign Minister Diogo Freitas do Amaral after they met for discussion on ways of boosting Portugal-MSAR ties. Under the accord, staff from the MSAR's economic and trade office in Portugal, and those from the Portuguese Consulate General and Portugal's foreign trade promotion representative office in the MSAR will enjoy the exemption. At their meeting, Ho also wished success for the forum on economic and trade cooperation between China and Portuguese-speaking countries scheduled for September in Macau. The Portuguese minister hoped that the MSAR and Portugal would further strengthen their political, economic and cultural links. Both are convinced that Macau will continue to play its role as a platform between China and Portugal and between China and the Europe Union. PRC Laws and Regulations

PRC Regulations on the Management of Mapping Results, adopted by the 136th State Council executive meeting on 17 May 2006, will come into force with effect from 1 September 2006. (Decree No. 469 of the PRC State Council, signed by Wen Jiabao, Premier of the State Council, on 27 May 2006) These regulations consist of six chapters with 32 articles. (Full text: RMRB, 20 Jun 06)

The **(Sixth) Amendment to the Criminal Law of the People's Republic of China** was passed at the 22nd meeting of the 10th NPC Standing Committee on 29 June 2006. It is now promulgated for implementation beginning from the date of its promulgation. (Presidential Decree No. 51, signed by State President Hu Jintao on 29 June 2006) (Full text: RMRB, 30 Jun 06) Amendment (Sixth) to the Criminal Law of the People's Republic of China (Adopted at the 22nd Session of the Standing Committee of the 10th National People's Congress on 29 June 2006) 1. Article 134 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "Whoever causes major casualties or other grave consequences as a result of violations of security management rules during production and operations shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention; if the circumstances are particularly flagrant, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than seven years in prison. "Whoever forces other people to undertake risky operations in violation of rules and regulations, thereby causing major casualties or other grave consequences, shall be sentenced to not more than five years in prison or to criminal detention; if the circumstances are particularly flagrant, the offender shall be

sentenced to not less than five years in prison."2. Article 135 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "Where safety production facilities or conditions do not comply with state rules and regulations, thereby causing major casualties or other grave consequences, the person in charge who is directly responsible and other persons with direct responsibility shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention; if the circumstances are particularly flagrant, they shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than seven years in prison."3. A sentence shall be added to Article 135 of the Criminal Law as part of Article 135: "Where large-scale mass activities are held in violation of safety management rules, thereby causing major casualties or other grave consequences, the person in charge who is directly responsible and other persons with direct responsibility shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention; if the circumstances are particularly flagrant, the offenders shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than seven years in prison."4. A sentence shall be added to Article 139 of the Criminal Law as part of Article 139: "Whoever is responsible for reporting a safety-related accident does not report it or misrepresents it after it occurs, thereby delaying rescue operations, shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention if the circumstances are serious; if the circumstances are particularly serious, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than seven years in prison."5. Article 161 shall be amended to read: "Where a company or an enterprise that has a duty to disclose information to shareholders and the public under the law provides false financial accounting reports or financial accounting reports that conceal important facts, or does not disclose other important information pursuant to rules and regulations when said information shall be disclosed under the law, thereby seriously compromising the interests of shareholders or other people or otherwise resulting in serious circumstances, the person in charge who is directly responsible and other persons with direct responsibility shall be sentenced

to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention and shall be fined concurrently or severally not less than 20,000 yuan but not more than 200,000 yuan."6. A sentence shall be added to Article 162 of the Criminal Law as part of Article 162: "Where a company or an enterprise falsely declares bankruptcy through concealing property and assuming fictitious debts, or by transferring or disposing of property through other means, thereby seriously compromising the interests of creditors or other people, the person in charge who is directly responsible and other persons with direct responsibility shall be sentenced to not more than five years in prison or to criminal detention and shall be fined concurrently or severally not less than 20,000 yuan but not more than 200,000 yuan."7. Article 163 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "An employee of a company, an enterprise, or any other unit who takes advantage of his or her position to demand or illegally accept valuables from other people in exchange for favours shall be sentenced to not more than five years in prison or to criminal detention if the sum is considerable; if the sum is huge, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than five years, with the concurrent sentence of confiscating property. "An employee of a company, an enterprise, or any other unit who takes advantage of his or her position during economic exchanges to receive for personal possession rebates and processing fees under various names in violation of state rules and regulations shall be punished pursuant to the provisions of the preceding paragraph. "Where an employee who conducts official business in a state-owned company, enterprise, or unit, or where an employee from a state-owned company, enterprise, or unit sent to conduct official business in a non-state-owned company, enterprise, or unit commits any of the acts in the preceding two paragraphs, the offender shall be deemed guilty and punished pursuant to the provisions of Articles 385 and 386 of this law."8. The first paragraph of Article 164 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "Whoever gives valuables to an employee of a company, an enterprise, or any other unit to seek improper benefits shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison

or to criminal detention if the sum is considerable; if the sum is huge, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than 10 years in prison or be fined concurrently.⁹ A sentence shall be added to Article 169 of the Criminal Law as part of Article 169: "A member of the board of directors or supervisors or a senior manager of a listed company who violates his or her fiduciary duties towards the company and takes advantage of his or her position to manipulate the listed company for the purpose of engaging in any of the following acts, thereby causing significant losses to the listed company's interests, shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention and be fined concurrently or severally; if particularly significant losses to the listed company's interests occur, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than seven years in prison and be fined concurrently: "(1) Providing funds, goods, services, or other assets without compensation to other units or individuals; "(2) Providing or receiving funds, goods, services, or other assets on clearly unfair terms; "(3) Providing funds, goods, services, or other assets to units or individuals who are clearly insolvent; "(4) Providing guarantees to units or individuals who are clearly insolvent, or providing guarantees to other units or individuals without valid reasons; "(5) Giving up creditor's claims or assuming debts without valid reasons; and "(6) Compromising the listed company's interests through other means. "Where the party that holds a controlling stake in or actually controls the listed company instigates a member of the board of directors or supervisors or a senior manager of the listed company to perpetrate any of the acts listed in the preceding paragraph, the offender shall be punished pursuant to the provisions of the preceding paragraph. "Where the party that holds a controlling stake in or actually controls the listed company that commits any of the crimes listed in the preceding paragraph is a unit, the unit in question shall be fined, and the person in charge who is directly responsible and other persons with direct responsibility shall be punished pursuant to the provisions of the first paragraph."¹⁰ A sentence shall be

added to Article 175 of the Criminal Law as part of Article 175: "Whoever secures a loan, acceptance of bills, a letter of credit, or a letter of guarantee from a bank or any other financial institution through fraudulent means, thereby causing significant losses to the bank or financial institution in question or resulting in other serious circumstances, shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention and be fined concurrently or severally; if particularly significant losses are inflicted on the bank or financial institution in question or other particularly serious circumstances occur, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than seven years in prison or be fined concurrently. "A unit that commits any of the crimes listed in the preceding paragraph shall be fined, and the person in charge who is directly responsible and other persons with direct responsibility shall be punished, pursuant to the provisions of the preceding paragraph."¹¹ Article 182 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "Whoever manipulates the securities or futures market in any of the following circumstances shall be sentenced to not more than five years in prison or to criminal detention and be fined concurrently or severally if the circumstances are serious; if the circumstances are particularly serious, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than five years but not more than 10 years in prison and be concurrently fined: "(1) Acting alone or conspiring with others to pool their ample sources of funds, stock holdings, or positions, or taking advantage of access to information, to jointly or successively engage in trades in order to rig securities and futures trading prices or volumes; "(2) Acting in collusion with others to trade in securities and futures at the times, prices, and methods agreed upon in advance in order to influence securities and futures trading prices or volumes; "(3) Trading in securities among accounts actually controlled by oneself or selling futures contracts to or buying futures contracts from oneself in order to influence securities and futures trading prices or volumes; and "(4) Manipulating the securities or futures market through other means. "A unit that commits any of the crimes listed in the preceding paragraph shall

be fined, and the person in charge who is directly responsible and other persons with direct responsibility shall be punished, pursuant to the provisions of the preceding paragraph."¹² A sentence shall be added to Article 185 of the Criminal Law as part of Article 185: "Where a commercial bank, a securities exchange, a futures exchange, a securities company, a futures brokerage firm, an insurance company, or any other financial institution uses without authorization its customers' funds or other property entrusted to its care by its customers in violation of its fiduciary duties, and if the circumstances are serious, the unit in question shall be fined, and the person in charge who is directly responsible and other persons with direct responsibility shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention and be concurrently fined not less than 30,000 yuan but not more than 300,000 yuan; if the circumstances are particularly serious, the offenders shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than 10 years in prison and be fined not less than 50,000 yuan but not more than 500,000 yuan. "Where a public fund management agency such as a social security fund management agency or a housing reserve fund management agency, an insurance company, an insurance asset management company, or a securities investment fund management company uses funds in violation of state rules and regulations, the person in charge who is directly responsible and other persons with direct responsibility shall be punished pursuant to the provisions of the preceding paragraph."¹³ The first and second paragraphs of Article 186 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "An employee of a bank or any other financial institution who extends loans in violation of state rules and regulations shall be sentenced to not more than five years in prison or to criminal detention and be concurrently fined not less than 10,000 yuan but not more than 100,000 yuan if the sum is huge or if significant losses occur; if the sum is particularly huge or if particularly significant losses occur, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than five years in prison and be concurrently fined not less than 20,000 yuan but not more than 200,000 yuan. "An employee of

a bank or any other financial institution who grants loans to an interested party in violation of state rules and regulations shall be heavily punished pursuant to the provisions of the preceding paragraph.¹⁴ The first paragraph of Article 187 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "An employee of a bank or any other financial institution who takes in a customer's funds but does not credit them to the account in question shall be sentenced to not more than five years in prison or to criminal detention and be concurrently fined not less than 20,000 yuan but not more than 200,000 yuan if the sum is huge or if significant losses occur; if the sum is particularly huge or if particularly significant losses occur, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than five years in prison and be concurrently fined not less than 50,000 yuan but not more than 500,000 yuan."¹⁵ The first paragraph of Article 188 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "An employee of a bank or any other financial institution who issues a letter of credit or guarantee, a negotiable instrument, a certificate of deposit, or a creditworthiness certificate in violation of rules and regulations shall be sentenced to not more than five years in prison or to criminal detention if the circumstances are serious; if the circumstances are particularly serious, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than five years in prison."¹⁶ The first paragraph of Article 191 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "Whoever knowingly obscures or conceals the sources and nature of proceeds and returns derived from narcotics crimes, organized crimes in the nature of those committed by criminal syndicates, terrorist crimes, smuggling, crimes involving corruption and bribery, crimes disrupting financial management order, and crimes involving financial fraud in any of the following circumstances shall have the proceeds and returns derived from any of the aforementioned crimes confiscated, sentenced to not more than five years in prison or to criminal detention, and concurrently or severally fined not less than 5 per cent but not more than 20 per cent of the sum of the money laundered; if the circumstances are serious, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than five years but not more than

10 years in prison and be concurrently fined not less than 5 per cent but not more than 20 per cent of the sum of money laundered: "(1) Providing an account for the funds; "(2) Assisting in the conversion of property into cash, financial bills, or negotiable securities; "(3) Assisting in the transfer of funds through transfers into other accounts or by other methods of settlement; "(4) Assisting in remitting funds overseas; and "(5) Obscuring or concealing the sources and nature of the proceeds and returns derived from crimes through other means."¹⁷ A sentence shall be added to Article 262 of the Criminal Law as part of Article 262: "Whoever organizes handicapped people or minors who are under 14 years old through violent or coercive means to go begging shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention and be fined concurrently; if the circumstances are serious, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than seven years in prison and be fined concurrently."¹⁸ Article 303 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "Whoever gathers people for the purpose of engaging in profit-oriented gambling or makes a living off gambling shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention or placed under surveillance and be fined concurrently. "Whoever runs a gambling den shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention or placed under surveillance and be fined concurrently; if the circumstances are serious, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than 10 years in prison and be fined concurrently."¹⁹ Article 312 of the Criminal Law shall be amended to read: "Whoever knowingly harbours, transfers, acquires, sells on behalf of others, or obscures or conceals via other means the proceeds and returns derived from crimes shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention or placed under surveillance and be fined concurrently or severally; if the circumstances are serious, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than seven years in prison and be fined concurrently."²⁰ A sentence shall be added to Article 399 of the Criminal Law as part of Article 399:

"Where a person performing arbitration duties under the law perverts the law to render a ruling in contravention of the facts and the law during the course of arbitration activities, he or she shall be sentenced to not more than three years in prison or to criminal detention if the circumstances are serious; if the circumstances are particularly serious, the offender shall be sentenced to not less than three years but not more than seven years in prison."²¹ This amendment shall take effect upon the date of its promulgation. (Xinhua, 29 Jun 06, in BBC PF, 6 Jul 06)

Compulsory Education Law of the People's Republic of China, adopted at the 4th meeting of the 6th NPC on 12 April 1986 and revised at the 22nd meeting of the 10th NPC Standing Committee on 29 June 2006. It will come into effect on September 1, 2006. (Presidential Decree No. 52, signed by State President Hu Jintao on 29 June 2006) (Full text: RMRB, 30 Jun 06) This law consist of eight chapters with 63 articles. The NPC Standing Committee on 29 June 2006 adopted the amendment to the Compulsory Education Law, aiming to give equal compulsory education to children in cities and in the countryside. The revised law aims to give children in both cities and the countryside nine years of free compulsory education but the tuition charges will not be completely waived for a few years as clauses in the law still have to be approved by the State Council. The expenditures will be jointly shouldered by the central government and local governments. And local governments should put the expenditure for compulsory education in their budgets. Chen Xiaoya, Vice-Minister of Education said if governments fail to pay for the compulsory education in time, they will be disciplined. She said the main aim of the law is to offer equal education to children no matter whether they live in the city or in the countryside. The revised law said the children of migrant workers will enjoy equal education rights as children in cities and the education rights of children with disabilities should be also secured. In cities, education resources, such as teachers, school facilities, programs designs and investment, should be equally allocated among schools.

There will no longer be a division of schools into key schools and common ones, according to the revised law. In a bid to improve education quality in rural schools, the law also requires teachers in urban schools to work in rural schools for a certain time to make up for the inadequate rural education resources. (XNA, 29 Jun 06)

Beijing, 6 July: China has issued its **first regulation to standardize the investment activities of the 166 major state-owned enterprises** (SOEs) under the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission. The regulation described the “significant responsibility” of the commission to supervise the investment activities of major SOEs as these companies, with combined assets of 10.6 trillion yuan, had a great bearing on the country’s economic health and industrial safety. Although most SOEs already conform to the standards and channel investment into their core businesses, problems such as blind investment and ineffective capital management still exist. About 5 per cent of the 1 trillion yuan invested by major SOEs in 2004 went into sideline businesses. A source with the commission said a few companies had branched into “too many sideline businesses” and failed to make good use of their resources. The regulation will apply only to the most frequent activities such as investment in fixed assets, property rights purchases and investment in long-term stockholder’s rights. Other activities, especially complicated monetary investment, will be standardized through other regulations. The document said the right of companies in making independent investment decisions must be respected by the supervising authorities. The role of the commission was “not to make decisions for enterprises”, but to “examine and verify their developing strategies, help sharpen their cutting edges by focusing on major business and to secure the value of state-owned assets.” It also stipulated that the commission must track the whole process of investment activity so as to identify flaws and suggest feasible improvements.
