Vice-Premier Wu Yi Wu Yi will head a new taskforce to steer the nation-wide crackdown on unsafe food and an accompanying publicity offensive amid serious scares at home and abroad over the quality of mainland-made products. The State Council had taken three steps to improve product safety, Zhou Baihua, director of the General Administration for Industry and Commerce, said in a report on the central government's website on 6 August. It would set up a group on quality work, which would comprise Ms Wu and officials from related central ministries and agencies, he said. It had also decided to launch a quality improvement campaign focused on food safety and to wage a battle „to guide public opinion“, Mr Zhou said. In a recent cabinet meeting, Premier Wen Jiabao ordered increased vigilance over food and drug safety. The meeting introduced a regulation that demanded stronger supervision and outlined hefty punishments for manufacturers of dangerous goods. The moves highlight the leadership's focus on winning back public confidence about food safety at home and international confidence in mainland exports, which have been found to contain dangerous levels of toxic chemicals. In a separate report, the State Council's General Office said the government would mobilise people from all walks of life to take part in a nationwide campaign focusing on the quality of specific products in selected regions. According to Xinhua, the campaign would begin in second half of this month and the administration had already espatched six teams to the provinces to inspect food safety and the pork market. The *Beijing News* said yesterday that inspectors had removed five brands of dried-fish snacks from shop shelves in the capital because they contained formaldehyde, a preservative and embalming fluid that has been linked to cancer in humans. A range of mainland exports, from pet food to seafood products, toys and toothpaste, has been found to be unsafe or dangerously contaminated, leading to a barrage of international criticism. Su Shulin (苏树林)

BEIJING, Aug. 10 (Xinhua) – China Petroleum & Chemical Corporation (Sinopec) has appointed Su Shulin as its new chairman, indicating the state-owned corporation may be expanding its focus on upstream operations.

After being elected as a director of the third session of the board at the second extraordinary general meeting of Sinopec this year, Su was elected chairman at the following meeting held by the board of directors.

His appointment came as no surprise as he had been nominated as general manager and Party secretary of China Petrochemical Corporation (Sinopec Group), Sinopec's parent company, in June after Chen Tonghai resigned both posts.

Chen also resigned as a director and chairman of the board of Sinopec "for personal reasons", which have yet to be explained.

A former senior executive president of PetroChina Co. Ltd, another state-owned oil giant, Su's appointment as the leader of the

largest oil refiner of Asia may indicate a change in Sinopec's business development.

Su, 45, formerly worked at the Daqing oil field in northeast China and is familiar with the upstream operations of the oil sector. Usually senior executives of Sinopec come from the refining and petrochemical sectors. Su is expected to drive the prosperous upstream sector for Sinopec which has been importing large amounts of crude oil to feed its refining and petrochemical sector and is trying to develop more oil and gas resources at home and abroad.

Before leading Sinopec, Su worked as a senior government official of the northeastern province of Liaoning for less than one year.

Sinopec, listed in Shanghai, Hong Kong, New York and London, garnered 50.7 billion yuan (6.7 billion U.S. dollars) in net profits last year, a growth of 28.1 percent on the previous year (XNA, 10 Aug 07) Su is an alternate member of the CCP CC.

Su Zhiqian (苏支前)

Congo (July 26)

Brazzaville, July 26 (Xinhua) - Republic of Congo and China signed a protocol agreement on the cancellation of an "important part" of debt owed by the country to China, totalling 30.6bn CFA francs (about 64m US dollars), according to official sources.

"The protocol agreement concerns the debt relief. China supports Republic of Congo's economic development which has already attained the level of the world's most indebted nations (PPTe) initiative, and would like to assist it to achieve the completion point of this initiative," said the Chinese ambassador Wo Ruidi.

The Chinese diplomat signed the agreement with the Congolese economic, finance and budget minister Pacifique Isoibeka who said "this protocol agreement falls within the framework of strengthening cooperation between the two countries."

According to Wo, China has already cancelled, since 2001, ten loans owned by Congo, or the equivalent of 75m US dollars.

"By cancelling an important part of its debt, China is offering Congo the opportunity of allocating the cancelled part of the debt to fund other projects," Isoibeka said.

Since 2003, China has provided 85 per cent of the 280m U.S. dollars of the total cost for the construction of a 120 megawatts power dam, the largest in Congo, in the northern region on the country, according to sources. (XNA, 26 Jul 07)

Croatia (July 26)

Belgrade, July 26 (Xinhua) - Officials of the Croatian Red Cross and the Chinese Red Cross signed a three-year cooperation agreement, said reports reaching here from the Croatian capital Zagreb.

The agreement regulates the exchange of experience in water rescue operations and search and rescue operations, and also covers assistance to locals in case of disasters, the Croatian news agency HINA reported.

The agreement was signed by the Croatian Red Cross executive president Nenad Javornik and the Chinese Red Cross vice-president, Guo Changjiang, said the reports. ... (XNA, 26 Jul 07)

Kazakhstan (Aug 18)

Astana, 18 August: During Chinese President Hu Jintao's visit to Kazakhstan, a number of documents were signed in Astana on Saturday [18 August], a correspondent of the Interfax-Kazakhstan [news] agency has reported.

The Chinese leader and Kazakh President Nursultan Nazarbayev signed a joint communique.

A Kazakh-Chinese intergovernmental agreement on cooperation in building and using a gas pipeline Kazakhstan-China was also signed.

An agreement was also signed in the form of notes' exchange between the governments of Kazakhstan and China on opening China's general consulate in Almaty.

Moreover, the first additional agreement was signed between Kazakhstan's national oil and gas company KazMunayGaz and China's CNPC on principles of cooperation in the construction of the Kazakhstan-China oil pipeline's second section.

In the presidents' presence, a programme was signed on cooperation between Kazakhstan and China in non-raw material economic sectors, as was an agreement between Kazakhstan's Ministry of Industry and Trade and China's Ministry of Commerce on the use of import certificates. Kyrgyzstan (Aug 14)

Belgrade, Bishkek, 14 August: A ceremony to sign 12 interstate documents was held at the Kyrgyz Republic's Government House as part of a state visit by Chinese President Hu Jintao to Kyrgyzstan. President Kurmanbek Bakiyev and his Chinese counterpart, Hu Jintao, signed a "Joint declaration between the Kyrgyz Republic and the People's Republic of China on further deepening relations, neighbourliness and cooperation".

Also, representatives of different ministries and departments signed the following agreements:

An intergovernmental agreement on cooperation in the area of quarantining animals; a government agreement on cooperation in fighting drug trafficking, abuse of narcotics, psychotropic substances and precursors; an agreement between the education ministries of the Kyrgyz Republic and the People's Republic of China on opening a Confucius Institute; a memorandum on cooperation in protecting the environment and in rationally using it; an intergovernmental agreement on technical and economic cooperation; a framework agreement between the Kyrgyztelecom open joint-stock company and the State Development Bank of the People's Republic of China on cooperation in financing; a contract between the Yuzhno-Kyrgyz Tsement [southern Kyrgyz cement] joint-stock company and the Eximbank of the People's Republic of China; and [an agreement on] exchanging letters on allocating no-strings resources for building a hospital. Protocols on the handover and reception of (30) vehicles and sanitary and harvesting vehicles, as well as materials necessary for making preparations for hosting an SCO [Shanghai Cooperation Organization] summit [scheduled for 16 August in Bishkek] were

Laos (Aug 23)

Beijing, Aug. 23 (Xinhua) - China and Laos signed six deals on cooperation in various fields in a bid to further boost their traditional friendship.

Chinese Premier Wen Jiabao and visiting Laotian Prime Minister Bouasone Bouphavanh witnessed the signing ceremony following their one-hour talks at the Great Hall of People in Beijing.

The six deals involves cooperation in such fields as food safety, loans and aeroplane programmes.

Premier Wen suggested the two countries enhance mutually-beneficial cooperation, focusing on areas like agriculture, infrastructure, energy and mining.

The two countries should jointly push forward Mekong River subregional cooperation and fight against transnational crimes, said Wen. ... This is Bouasone's first official visit to China since taking office in June, 2006. ... (XNA, 23 Aug 07)

up 11 additional business domains, covering computing, market research, translation, public utilities and social services, from 2008 onwards.

The threshold for Macau banks and financial institutions entering the mainland market will also be relaxed under the agreement.

For the convention and exhibition sector, Macau businesses will be allowed to hold exhibitions in Guangdong Province and Shanghai, under the condition that the services are paid for outside mainland China. They will also be allowed to provide international exhibition services to clients in Guangdong and Shanghai.

Macau travel agents can set up branches in mainland China on its own, provided its annual turnover is USD15 million rather than USD25 million as previous agreements ruled.

Macau residents are also able to seat for the Chinese insurance broker exam under the new agreement.

Meanwhile, concessionary measures are to be introduced for Macau banks opening businesses in Central and Western China, Northeastern China and guangdong Province. They will also be encouraged to set up banks in rural areas.

The agreement was signed by the Secretary for the Economy and Finance Tam Pak Yuen and Vice-Minister of Commerce Liao Xiaoqi, at the witness of the Chief Executive Ho Hau Wah and Deputy Director of the State Council's Hong Kong and Macau Office Chen Zuoer. International Agreements

Beijing, Aug. 19 (Xinhua) - The Chinese government has approved six more countries as the destinations for outbound tourist groups, said sources with the China National Tourism Administration.

The six countries are Oman, Morocco, Monaco, Syria, Namibia and Bulgaria.

In the first half of the year, China's outbound tourism saw rapid growth, with the number of tourists up 14.04 per cent from the same period of last year, said the administration.

The country remained Asia's largest source of outbound tourism last year, with 34 million Chinese tourists travelling abroad, up 10 per cent year-on-year.

China has so far approved 132 countries and regions as destinations for outbound tourism, 86 of which receive Chinese tourist groups. (XNA, 19 Aug 07)

PRC Laws and Regulations

Regulations of the People's Republic of China on Sailors, adopted at the 172nd State Council executive meeting on 28 March 2007. The regulations will be effective as of 1 September 2007. (Decree No. 494 of the PRC State Council, signed by Wen Jiabao, Premier of the State Council, on 14 April 2007) The regulations consist of eight chapters with 73 articles. (Full text: RMRB, 14 Aug 07)

Regulation on the supervision and management of civil nuclear security facilities. The regulation, with 62 articles in eight chapters, will take effect on 1 January 2008. (Decree No. 500 of the PRC State Council, signed by Wen Jiabao, Premier of the State Council, on 7 July 2007)

Regulation on the supervision and management of railway accidents, adopted at the 182nd State Council executive meeting on 27 June 2007. The regulation, with 41 articles in eight chapters, will take effect on 1 September 2007. (Decree No. 501 of the PRC State Council, signed by Wen Jiabao, Premier of the State Council, on 11 July 2007) (Full text: RMRB, 17 Aug 07)

State Council Special Regulations on Strengthening Supervision and Management Over the Safety of Food and Other Products, adopted at the 186th State Council executive meeting on 25 July 2007. These regulations become effective upon promulgation. (Decree No. 503 of the PRC State Council, signed by Wen Jiabao, Premier of the State Council, on 26 July 2007) (Full text: RMRB, 28 July 07) These regulations consist of 20 articles.

Beijing, July 27 (Xinhua) - China's cabinet publicized a special regulation on the supervision of food safety amid serious criticism from home and abroad of the quality of food products made in China.

The regulation issued by the State Council is aimed at intensifying the control over producers and distributors dealing with food products. The main points are:

- Inspection and quarantine authorities, as well as commercial and drug supervisors, should establish positive and negative records for Chinese food exporters and submit the records to the media regularly.
- Local governments at county level and above are mainly responsible for the supervision of food product safety.
- Exporters of food products who provide fake quality certificates or evade quality and quarantine inspections will be fined three times the product's value.

China has faced a barrage of international criticism over the state of its food industry in the first six months of the year following a series of scandals.

The US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) announced at the end of March that pet food imported from China had caused the deaths of cats and dogs. Later, in May, Chinese toothpaste was found to contain diethylene glycol in Central America and the United States. Japan, Singapore, Australia and other countries sent back millions of toothpaste tubes and Canada halted imports from China.

The FDA also refused seafood products from China in June, saying that it would not resume imports until Chinese exporters provided necessary safety certificates.

The regulation has also set out rules on the supervision of imported food products.

- China's imported food products should meet both the national compulsory standards and criteria in the contracts signed by Chinese importers and foreign exporters.
- Chinese importers should make detailed records of domestic distributions for imported food products and the records should be kept for at least two years.
- Inspection and quarantine authorities should establish a blacklist for foreign exporters and to seriously punish domestic importers who introduced unqualified food products. (XNA, 27 Jul 07)

["Special State Council Regulations for Tightening up the Control of the Safety of Foods and Other Products" - published with authorization]

Beijing, 27 Jul (Xinhua) - Special State Council Regulations for Tightening up the Control of the Safety of Foods and Other Products
Article 1: These regulations are formulated for tightening up the supervision and control over the safety of foods and other products; for specifying the responsibilities of producers and business operators, supervisory departments, and local people's governments; for tightening up the coordination and cooperation between supervisory and administrative departments; and for safeguarding the safety of people's physical health and lives.

Article 2: With the exception of foods, the term "products" used in these regulations also include agricultural products used for food, pharmaceuticals and other products relevant to the safety of people's physical health and lives.

Where the law has rules that prescribe product safety, those rules should apply; and where the law has no rules that prescribe product safety, or where the rules are unclear, these regulations should apply.

Article 3: Producers and business operators are responsible for the safety of products they produce and sell. They may not produce and sell products that do not meet the requirements prescribed in the law.

Where a business whose production and marketing must be licensed or certified as required by the law or administrative regulations, its production and business operations must be based on the requirements prescribed in the law. A business whose

production and business operations not in conformity with conditions and requirements prescribed in the law, or a businesses that produces and markets products not in conformity with the requirements prescribed in the law, the agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business and pharmaceutical administrations must, acting in accordance with their respective responsibilities, confiscate their illegal incomes, products and tools as well as the equipment and raw materials used for its illicit production; impose on it a fine of 50,000 yuan if the cash value of this business' merchandise is under 5,000 yuan; impose on it a fine of 100,000 yuan if the cash value of its merchandise is above 5,000 yuan but under 10,000 yuan; and impose on it a fine between 10 and 20 times the cash value of its merchandise if the cash value of the merchandise is above 10,000 yuan. If the outcome caused by this business is serious, the original licensing department should revoke its license. And if this business is found guilty of engaging in illicit business operations or having committed other crimes such as producing or marketing bogus and shoddy products, it must be held criminally accountable.

If a producer or business operator continues to engage in production or business operations which are not in conformity with the conditions and requirements stated in the law, the original licensing department must revoke its license and make known its name on the principal local media; and if the business is found guilty of operating the business illegally or producing and marketing bogus and shoddy products, it must be held criminally accountable.

If a business that requires a license for its operations but it engages in production or business operations without a license, the agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business and pharmaceutical administrations must, acting in accordance with their respective responsibilities, confiscate this business' illegal incomes and products as well as the tools, equipment and raw materials used for the illegal production; impose on it a fine of 100,000 yuan if the cash value of this business' merchandise is below 10,000 yuan; impose on it a fine between 10 and 20 times the cash value of its merchandise if the cash value of the merchandise is above 10,000 yuan; and hold it criminally accountable if this business is found guilty of having engaged in unlawful operations.

Trade associations concerned must tighten up their work of disciplining their trades and supervising the production and business operations of the producers and business operators; intensify their efforts in educating the public on health knowledge; and guide consumers to choose products produced and marketed by lawful producers and business operators and products with legal trademarks.

Article 4: The raw materials, supplements, additives and agricultural ingredients that a producer uses to produce products must meet the regulations in the law and the rules in administrative regulations and the standards mandated by the state.

Any business that unlawfully uses raw materials, supplements, additives and agricultural ingredients in violation of the preceding paragraph, the agricultural, public health, quality inspection,

commercial and pharmaceutical administrations must, acting in accordance with their respective responsibilities, confiscate its illegal incomes and impose on it a fine of 20,000 yuan if the cash value of its merchandise is under 5,000 yuan; a fine of 50,000 yuan if the cash value of the merchandise is above 5,000 yuan but under 10,000 yuan; or a fine between five and ten times the cash value of the merchandise if it is above 10,000 yuan. If the business' unlawful act has caused any serious consequence, the license issuer must revoke this business' license. And if this business is found guilty of producing and marketing bogus and shoddy commodities, it must be held criminally accountable.

Article 5: A seller must establish and execute the rules for inspecting and stocking merchandise, check the business credentials of the suppliers, check the papers that certify the quality of products and the trademarks of products, and establish a machine account [tai zhang] to factually record the names, specifications, quantities and suppliers of the products it has purchased as well as the ways of contacts with the suppliers and the time the products are purchased. A wholesaler should establish a machine account to factually record the varieties, specifications, quantities, and the flows of its merchandise. A producer that sells at trade fair the goods it produces has the obligations to establish a machine account of its products according to the regulations set for the wholesaler. The machine accounts for purchases and products sold should be kept for at least two years. A seller should, according to the lot number of products, solicit from the supplier an inspection report that meets the conditions prescribed by the law, or a copy of the inspection report that has been signed or sealed by the supplier. The seller may not sell those products that cannot provide an inspection report or a copy of the inspection report.

If the seller that violates the rules above, the business and pharmaceutical administrations should, according to their respective responsibilities, order it to stop selling the products. If the seller is unable to provide an inspection report or a copy of the inspection report for the products it sells, its illegal incomes and the products it sells against the law shall be confiscated, and it will receive a fine equal to three times the cash value of the merchandise. If the seller has caused any serious consequence, the original license issuer will revoke its license.

Article 6: At a market where products are traded collectively, the enterprises that operate there, the businesses that rent out business areas, and the businesses that sponsor exhibition-marketing fairs must check the credentials of those businesses that want to market their goods, verify the sellers' accountability for the safety of their products, periodically check the sellers' business environments, conditions, internal safety rules to see whether the products marketed there meet the requirements prescribed by the law. And if they find the sales do not meet the requirements prescribed by the law or are against other regulations, they should immediately stop the sales and report the situation to the business administrative authorities in the area.

If a business violates the rules above, the business administration should impose on it a fine between 1,000 and 50,000 yuan; and if the case is serious, the business should be ordered to suspend its business operations for improvement; and if the business has caused any serious consequence, it should have its operating license revoked.

Article 7: A business that produces export products should make sure their exports meet the criteria set by the importing countries (regions) or the contract requirements. If it has been prescribed in the law that a product can be exported only after inspection, then the product must pass the inspection conducted by a body that meets legal regulations.

Inspectors of export products must do their job in accordance with the law, administrative regulations, criteria, procedures and methods; and hold themselves accountable to the details stated in the inspection certificates.

Export/import quarantine authorities and business and pharmaceutical administrations should record the merits and demerits of those that produce and market export products and publicize the information. They may simplify the inspection procedures for those producers and business operators that have a good track record.

If a business that produces and markets export products evades product inspection or resort to fraud, the export/import quarantine authorities and pharmaceutical administration must, acting in accordance with their respective responsibilities, confiscate the illegal incomes and products and impose on this business a fine that is three times the cash value of the merchandise. And if the business' conduct constitutes a crime, the business must be held criminally accountable.

Article 8: Imports should meet the mandatory requirements of China's technical standards and the inspection requirements prescribed in the agreements that China have signed with the export countries (regions).

Quality inspection and pharmaceutical administrations manage imports according to the imports' different categories on the basis of the producers' and business operators' credibility, level of quality control, and the results from appraising the risks of the imports; and keep a record of the import recipients for management purpose. The import recipients must factually record the flows of the imports. The record must be kept for at least two years.

When quality inspection and pharmaceutical administrations discover products not in conformity with the requirements prescribed in the law, they may put the names of the purchasers of those products not in conformity with the requirements prescribed in the law, the names of the inspection declarants and the names of agents into their lists of those who have a bad track record. For those import purchasers and sellers who resort to fraud, quality inspection and pharmaceutical administrations must, acting in accordance with their respective responsibilities, confiscate their illegal incomes and products and impose on each of them a fine that is three times the cash value of the merchandise. Those whose

conduct constitutes a crime must be held criminally accountable. If the declarants and agents of imports resort to fraud, they must have their declaration credentials revoked and they must receive a fine equal to the cash value of the merchandise.

Article 9: When a producing business discovers that any product it has produced is potentially unsafe and may be hazardous to people's health and lives, it must make the information known to the public, notify the sellers to stop selling the product, inform consumers not to use the product, recall the product, and report the matter to the supervisory authorities; and all the sellers must immediately stop selling the product. When a seller discovers any product it sells is potentially unsafe and may be hazardous to people's health and lives, it must immediately stop selling the product, notify the producing enterprise or the supplier, and report the matter to supervisory authorities concerned.

If a producing enterprise or seller fails to undertake the obligations above, the agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business, and pharmaceutical administrations must, on the basis of their respective responsibilities, order the producing enterprise to recall the product, order the sellers to stop selling the product, impose on the producing enterprise a fine that is three times the cash value of the product, and impose on the seller a fine between 1,000 and 50,000 yuan. If the incident has caused any grave consequence, the licensing authorities must revoke the license.

Article 10: County-and higher-level people's governments must make their supervision over product safety one benchmark for evaluating their performance, hold themselves fully accountable for the safety of products produced in areas under their jurisdiction, exercise centralized leadership, coordinate the supervision in areas under their jurisdiction and build efficient mechanisms for tightening up coordination and supervision over the enforcement of the various administrative laws; create a supervisory responsibility system for appraising and evaluating the performance of the various supervisory and administrative departments. Under the centralized coordination of people's governments of corresponding levels, quality inspection, business and pharmaceutical administrations must do a good job in supervising product safety according to the law.

If a county or higher-level people's government fails to undertake its responsibilities of guiding and coordinating the supervision over product safety, and if product safety incidents repeatedly taken place in the administrative district in a year have created serious social impacts, the supervisory authorities, or authorities in charge of personnel appointment and dismissal, must discipline the principal government officials and persons in direct charge by meting out to them a serious demerit, by demoting them, or by dismissing them from offices.

Article 11: Within the scope of their responsibilities, State Council departments in charge of quality inspection, public health and agriculture must act as quickly as possible to draw up, revise or draft the necessary national standards and speed up establishing uniform standards which are coordinated, practical, scientific and rational.

Article 12: When county-and higher-level people's governments and their departments exercise supervision over product safety, they must undertake their responsibilities according to procedures and within the authority prescribed in the law; and they must do so openly, fairly and impartially. They may not mete out administrative penalty two or more times to the same lawless act committed by a producer or business operator. If a business operator is suspected for having committed a crime and should be held criminal accountable according to the law, it should be referred to the public security authorities in accordance with the Regulations for Administrative Law Enforcement Authorities for Transferring Criminal Suspects.

In accordance with their respective responsibilities, agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business and pharmaceutical administrations must supervise and inspect the producers and business operators under their supervision, record their performance in following the mandatory standards and requirements prescribed in the law, and then keep these records in files after they have been signed by the supervisors and inspectors. These records should serve as the main benchmarks for the periodical evaluations of the performance of the personal in charge. The public has the right to examine the supervision and inspection records.

Article 13: When a producer or business operator has any one of the following situations, agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business and pharmaceutical administrations must, in accordance with their respective responsibilities, take measures to correct the lawless acts, to stop any danger from taking place or minimize the danger that has taken place, and mete out punishments to them according to these regulations:

- (1) When it engages in production and business operations without a license as the law requires;
- (2) When it fails to engage in production and business operations according to the conditions and requirements prescribed in the law; or when it engages in production and business operations or sells products which are not in conformity with the requirements prescribed in the law after it has been licensed or certified;
- (3) When it continues to engage in production and business operations when its production and business operations no longer meet the conditions and requirements prescribed in the law;
- (4) When a producer fails to use raw materials, supplements, additives and agricultural ingredients according to the law, administrative regulations, and the standards mandated by the state.
- (5) When a seller fails to establish a system for purchasing, inspecting and stocking merchandise and fails to enforce this system; and when it fails to establish a machine account of product purchases;
- (6) When a producing enterprise or seller fails to undertake the obligations prescribed in these regulations after it finds the product it produces or sells is potentially unsafe and may be hazardous to people's health and their lives; or

(7) When a producing enterprise violates other regulations than those stipulated in the law, administrative regulations and these regulations.

If an agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business or pharmaceutical administration fails to undertake the responsibilities in the preceding paragraph and has caused any consequence, the supervisory authorities, or authorities in charge of personnel appointment and dismissal, should mete out punishments to their principal persons in charge, persons who are directly responsible and other personnel directly responsible by giving them a serious demerit or by demoting them; if the incident has caused any serious consequence, these personnel must be removed or expelled from their offices; and if the conduct of the principal persons in charge, the personnel who are directly in charge, and other personnel who should be held directly accountable constitute a crime, they must be held criminally accountable.

For those who violate these regulations, who abuse their authority, or who have been found to have neglected their duties, supervisory authorities, or authorities in charge of personnel appointment and dismissal, should mete out punishments to the principal responsible persons, personnel who are directly responsible, and other personnel who are directly responsible by demoting or dismissing them. And if the conduct of the principal responsible persons, personnel who are directly responsible and other personnel who are also directly responsible constitutes a crime, they must be held criminally accountable according to the law.

Article 14: When agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business, and pharmaceutical administrations find any conduct that violates these regulations and that is under their responsibility to intervene, they must immediately notify by writing and refer the case to the supervisory authorities that have the authority to handle the case. The departments with the authority to handle the case should immediately handle the case and must not shift the responsibility to any other department. And if the case has caused any consequence because it is not immediately handled or because it is shifted to other department, the supervisory authorities or authorities in charge of personnel appointment and dismissal must mete out punishments to their principal responsible persons, personnel who are directly responsible, or other personnel who bear direct responsibility by giving them a serious demerit or by demoting them.

Article 15: Agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business and pharmaceutical administrations can exercise the following authority when they undertake their responsibilities in supervising product safety:

- (1) They can conduct on-the-spot inspection at production and business areas;
- (2) They can check, copy, seal and hold in their custody the necessary contracts, bills, account books and other related information;
- (3) They can seal and hold in their custody those products not in conformity with the requirements prescribed in the law; and the raw

materials, supplements, additives and agricultural ingredients illegally used as well as the tools and equipment used for illicit production; and

(4) They can seal off the production and business areas hazardous to people's health and lives and the potentially dangerous areas.

Article 16: Agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business and pharmaceutical administrations must establish systems of keeping track of the lawless behaviours of producers and business operators, and record and make public their lawless behaviours; and revoke the operating licenses from those producers and business operators who have repeatedly violated the law.

Article 17: If an inspection and testing body issues a fraudulent report and this report has caused any serious consequence, the department that accredits the body's credentials shall revoke its inspection and testing credentials; and if the fraud constitutes a crime, the persons directly in charge and other personnel bearing direct responsibilities have be held criminally accountable.

Article 18: Whenever a product safety incident occurs, or when a product safety incident has caused any serious social impact, the agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business and pharmaceutical administrations must, within the scope of their respective responsibilities, immediately respond to the incident, take measures to control the situation from developing and minimize losses, and make public the information and handle the aftermath properly according to State Council regulations.

Article 19: Any organization and individual has the right to report those behaviours which are against these regulations. The departments that receive the information must keep the informant confidential. After the information reported has been verified and found to be factual, the department that handles the report should reward the informant.

Agricultural, public health, quality inspection, commercial, business and pharmaceutical administrations should make known their e-mail addresses and telephone numbers for informants to report wrongdoings. The reports received should be promptly and fully recorded and properly preserved. If a department receives a report about an issue that is under its responsibility, it must handle and verify the report, process it and give the informant a reply. And if the matter reported is not under this department's responsibility, then it should refer the information to the department that has the authority to handle the matter, and then tell the informant the way its information is being handled.

Article 20: These regulations become effective upon promulgation. (Xinhua, 27 Jul 07, in BBC PF, 2 Aug 07)

Enforcement regulations on the reduction of tax on the interest on personal bank savings. (Full text: RMRB, 22 Jul 07)

The State Council, or cabinet, announced on 20 July 2007 the reduction of tax on the interest on personal bank savings from 20 to five percent from August 15. The tax was introduced in November 1999 to encourage domestic consumption.

The reduction in savings interest tax would increase earnings from bank savings and would slow rapid increases in investment and rising inflation, the State Council said in a news release.

Experts said the measures would help to slow down China's fast economic growth, rapid increases in fixed asset investment and inflation. (http://english.gov.cn/2007-07/21/content_692280.htm, accessed 31 Jul 07)

BEIJING, August 2 (Xinhua) – The Authorities recently issued the **Regulations on the Military's Recruitment and Retention of High-Caliber Professional and Technical Personnel**,

as part of the current military personnel reform. The document, which was approved by Hu Jintao, chairman of China's Central Military Commission, contains 17 measures aiming at attracting top scientists and technicians.

Under the new regulations, the Army will appoint members of the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the Chinese Academy of Engineering Sciences as advisors, adopt a Chief Expert System by hiring top experts as leaders for major military research programs, employ civilian technicians as preparatory officers for important technical positions relating to military equipment and technology, provide better welfares and salaries to these specially-recruited experts, and recruit more post-doctorate researchers from civilians and offering better welfares to them.

The Army will also send more researchers and technicians to study in civilian universities and research institutions, form innovative work stations for major research programs, and organize internal "job exchange" to help scientists and technicians find their right positions in the Army.

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to scientists and technicians who have made outstanding contribution to the Army, according to the regulations.

The Authorities plan to spend more money for attracting and preserving top-level experts and set up a data bank on top-level experts in the Army, it says. (XNA, 2 Aug 07; Xinhua, 2 Aug 07, in BBC PF, 4 Aug 07)

BEIJING, Aug. 14 (Xinhua) – The Ministry of Justice (MOJ) has publicized a **new set of rules for judicial authentication** which will take effect on October 1.

The rules, passed by the MOJ on July 18, will take place of the existing rules released on Aug. 31, 2001, MOJ said.

Judicial authentication refers to the activities that authenticators identify, make judgments and offer expertise on the special issues involved in litigation by using scientific technologies or special knowledge.

The formal version of the new rules has five chapters and 40 clauses in all, including general principles, authorized authentication process legal documents issued by the authentication institutions and supplementary provisions.

The MOJ said they improve the original rules and release the new ones aiming to better adapt to social changes and ensure the high quality of judicial authentication.

According to MOJ, the formal version is released after the draft version publicized in 2005 to solicit the opinions from central and local governments, the judicial experts and the public.

The new rules addresses problems with most public complaints for their lawsuits, such as repeated or delayed authentication.

The new rules, for the first time, make clear that the judicial authentication institutions must reply to thrusters whether they can make authentication for their cases within seven working days.

The rules, also for the first time, stated clear that state or commercial secrets, individual privacy must not be divulged during the judiciary authentication process. (XNA, 14 Aug 07)
