Beijing has confirmed speculation that it will issue three licences for China's third-generation mobile service, which analysts expect to be granted by the end of the year after the completion of the industry restructuring. Without giving a timetable, the Ministry of Industry and Information, the National Development and Reform Commission and the Ministry of Finance released a joint statement saying the six telecommunications operators would be merged into three. The government would issue three 3G licences after the mergers to enable three operators – China Mobile, the world's biggest wireless carrier, China Telecommunications Group, the country's largest fixed-line operator, and China Unicom Group, smaller rival of China Mobile – to run fixed-line and mobile services, the statement said.

China Mobile will take over China Tietong (Railcom), which owns the nationwide railway-based telecommunications network, Xinhua reported on 24 May. It remains to be seen how China Mobile, which is absorbing Railcom to enter the slower-growing fixed-line business, will tackle impending competition. The government called for a merger of China Unicom and Netcom, the smaller of the country's two fixed-line carriers. (SCMP, 23, 26 May 08)

Under the revamp, three so-called full service operators will be created, with China Telecom Corp acquiring CDMA mobile-telephone operations from China Unicom, and Netcom and China Netcom Group Corp merging with Unicom's GSM business. China Mobile will acquire fixed-line business China Tietong. (SCMP, 27 May 08)

China Unicom, the smaller of the country's two mobile-telephone operators, will take over smaller fixed-line operator China Netcom Group Corp in a share swap valued up to HK\$182.77 billion, the companies announced on 2 June. The transactions between the Hong Kong-listed companies are a direct result of the central government's attempt to restructure the telecommunications industry into three full-service operators. Netcom will be delisted after the merger and folded into Unicom.

Hebei Province has formed a company that overtakes Baosteel Group Corp as China's biggest steelmaker. The local government on 11 June announced the establishment of Hebei Iron and Steel Group, which combines Tangshan Iron & Steel Group and Handan Iron & Steel Group, said a spokesman for Tangshan Steel's listed unit. Hebei Steel has annual production capacity of 31.75 million tonnes of the alloy, according to the combined output of Tangshan Steel (22.75m) and Handan Steel (9m) last year.

It is reported that Wang Yifang (see entry "Wang Yifang") will be appointed director of the newly founded group. Xinhua on 11 June quoted Hebei vice-governor Sun Ruibin as saying the government would strive to have Hebei Steel Group officially established by mid-July. (SCMP, 12 Jun 08;

Hong Kong SAR Agreement with Sri Lanka (Jun 16)

HONG KONG, June 16 (Xinhua) - Hong Kong and Sri Lanka signed an agreement on mutual legal assistance in criminal matters, the 25th pact Hong Kong had signed with other jurisdictions.

The agreement will come into force 30 days after the two sides inform each other they have complied with their entry requirements for the agreement.

Hong Kong Special Administrative Region government Secretary for Security Ambrose Lee and Sri Lankan Secretary to the Ministry of Justice and Law Reforms Suhada Gamalath signed the document.

According to the pact, both sides agreed to help with each other identifying and locating people, executing requests for search and seizure, effecting the temporary transfer of people in custody and to provide other assistance. (XNA, 16 Jun 08)

BEIJING, June 12 (Xinhua) - The mainland-based **Association for Relations Across the Taiwan Strait (ARATS)** and its Taiwan counterpart, **Straits Exchange Foundation (SEF)**, agreed to set up representative offices to each other's side.

Pang Chien-kuo, SEF deputy secretary-general, told the press here the agreement was made at the meeting between ARATS Chairman Chen Yunlin and SEF Chairman Chiang Pin-kun Thursday morning.

The offices would be founded to facilitate people's exchanges and travelling across the Strait, he said.

The issue would be discussed in the following meetings between the two sides, he added.

SEF and ARATS are authorized non-governmental organizations (NGO) engaged in talks on issues related to cross-Strait exchanges.

The two sides started negotiations for weekend chartered flights and mainland tourists travelling to Taiwan on 12 June. (XNA, 12 Jun 08)

Beijing, June 12 (CNA) - Taiwan and China agreed to set up reciprocal offices to deal with visa applications.

The visa offices will be set up respectively under Taiwan's Straits Exchange Foundation [SEF], and Beijing's Association for Relations Across the Taiwan Straits [ARATS], the two quasi-official agencies established by Taiwan and China to deal with cross-strait matters in the absence of official ties.

The agreement was concluded in talks here between a delegation of the Straits Exchange Foundation and its Chinese counterpart.

The meeting marked the resumption of dialogue between Taiwan and China after a hiatus of nearly ten years because of political differences.

Although millions of Taiwanese visit China each year, and 288,000 Chinese tourists visited Taiwan between 2002 and 2008, visa applications have to be dealt with by the respective representative offices of both sides in Hong Kong. [Text of ARATS-SEF Agreement on Mainland Residents Touring Taiwan - signed in Beijing on 13 June 2008]

Beijing, 13 Jun (Xinhua) - Chen Yunlin, president of the Association for Relations Across the Taiwan Straits [ARATS]; and Chiang Pin-kun [Jiang Bingkun], chairman of the Taiwan's Straits Exchange Foundation [SEF], signed in Beijing today, 13 June, the Cross-Strait Agreement on Mainland Residents Touring Taiwan. The full text of the agreement follows:

For the sake of promoting exchange between the people on the two sides of the Straits and cross-Straits tourism, and through consultations on an equal footing, ARATS and the incorporated SEF have reached the following agreement about mainland residents touring Taiwan:

1. Contacts

(1) The Association for Travel and Tourism Exchange Across the Straits (called Cross-Straits Tourism Association for short below) and the Taiwan Association for Cross-Strait Travel and Tourism (called Taiwan Tourism Association for short below) will jointly implement the matters agreed upon in this Agreement.

(2) ARATS and the incorporated SEF may make changes of this Agreement and other related matters through contacting each other.

2. Touring Arrangements

(1) The two sides agree that tours in Taiwan should be made by groups. Entry into Taiwan and exit from Taiwan, touring activities,

and going to Taiwan and returning to the mainland will all be group activities.

(2) The two sides agree to adjust such matters as the number of people in a group, the average daily quota, the length of stay, and the ways of going to Taiwan and returning to the mainland in accordance with situations on the basis of the principle for safety and the principle that adjustments should be made gradually. See Annex I for specific arrangements.

3. Tours Based on Trust

The two sides will jointly supervise travel agencies' business operations and services, prohibit such business conduct as collecting "zero/subzero [ling fu] group fees," encourage quality tour, and work together to provide tourists with proper guidance.

4. Safeguard of Rights and Interests

(1) The two sides will take active measures to simplify exit/entry procedures, provide services that facilitate tourism, and protect tourists' safety and legitimate rights and interests.

(2) The two sides agree to establish respective coordinating mechanisms for handling emergencies; cooperate with each other; forestall risks; take prompt and proper actions to handle travel disputes, emergencies and abrupt incidents; and carry out the obligations of informing each other.

5. Group-Formation Agencies and Reception Agencies

(1) The two sides should respectively control the credentials of group-formation and reception agencies, group leaders and tour guides; and notify each other in writing the names of the agencies, group leaders, and tour guides.

(2) Group-formation and reception agencies should sign business contracts (or agreements), keep them for records, and handle their businesses according to the rules prescribed in their contracts.

(3) In accordance with the rules of market operations, the group-formation and reception agencies should be responsible for the medical services and personal and air travel insurance essential for travellers.

(4) In case a traveller's legitimate rights and interests or safety are threatened or jeopardized, the group-formation and reception agencies should actively, promptly, effectively and properly handle the situation.

(5) The two sides should respectively handle those travel agencies that jeopardize travellers' legitimate rights and interests.

(6) The two sides should respectively guide and oversee the group-formation and reception agencies to make sure they protect tourists' legitimate rights and interests and that they undertake their responsibilities of ensuring travel safety on the basis of their contracts (or agreements).

6. Application Procedure

Group-formation and reception agencies should respectively handle tourists' passage procedures and mutually acknowledge these procedures. Tourists bearing valid papers enter Taiwan and depart Taiwan in groups.

7. Overstay

The two sides agree to establish working mechanisms for handling issues relevant to tourists' overstay in Taiwan, provide each other with the needed information and, after verifying the identities of those who overstay and considering the different situations, help them return to the mainland. Neither side may refuse to return or accept the tourists.

8. Mutual Establishment of Agencies

The two sides agree to establish offices in each other's side to take charge of travel-related matters and to provide tourists with prompt, efficient and effective services.

9. Executing and Changing the Agreement

(1) The two sides should abide by this agreement. The annexes of this agreement have the same effects of this agreement.

(2) Changing the agreement requires the two sides' consent through consultations, and the change must be acknowledged by writing.

10. Settlement of Disputes

The two sides should act as quickly as possible to resolve any dispute caused by application of this agreement.

11. Unresolved Issues

The two sides should appropriately address other unresolved issues, if any.

12. Agreements Becomes Effective After Signing

This agreement becomes effective seven days after it is signed.

This agreement is signed on 13 June [2008]. It has four copies - two copies for each side.

Annex I

Arrangements for Cross-Strait Travel and Tour

The arrangements made according to Article 1 of this Agreement are as follow:

1. The quota set by the reception side is limited to 3,000 people per day. The group-formation side makes arrangements according to market needs. The two sides may make adjustments the following year.
2. The number of tourists in each group must be at least 10 people but must not be more than 40 people.
3. A tourist group's stay in Taiwan may not exceed 10 days beginning with the second day of its arrival.
4. Tour in Taiwan will officially start on 18 July. The date, 4 July, will be the day the first group of tourists will arrive in Taiwan.

Annex 2

Controls for Cross-Strait Travel Cooperation

According to Articles 4, 5 and 7 of this Agreement, the two sides' tourism business should abide by the following controls:

1. The information concerning group-formation and reception agencies that the Cross-Strait Tourism Agency and the Taiwan Tourism Agency provide should include: names of the travel agency; and its person in charge, address, telephone number, fax number, e-mail address, name of contact, and mobile phone number. If a group-formation agency or a reception agency has changed the information, it should immediately notify the other side by writing.
2. For the sake of providing travel and tourism information and handle complaints, the Taiwan Tourism Agency should set up a hotline to provide tourism-related consultative services and to handle complaints.
3. The Cross-Straits Tourism Association and the Taiwan Tourism Association, as the points of contact for handling tourism-related disputes, overstays, emergencies and abrupt incidents, should create their respective mechanisms for handling emergencies,

exchange information in a timely manner, work in close coordination with each other, and properly settle those problems arising from mainland tourists in Taiwan.

4. The group-formation agency should provide the reception agency the names of the tourists in its group and other related information, and the group-formation agency should also assign a leader to the tourist group; and the reception agency should assign a tour guide for the group. If a problem appears during the tour, the group leader and tour guide should properly handle the problem through consulting each other and they shall report the problem to the group-formation agency and the reception agency.

5. The reception side should provide the group-formation agency the reference price of group tour.

6. The reception side may not guide and organize the mainland tourists to take part in gambling, pornographic and drug-related activities and other activities harmful to cross-Strait relations.

7. Both the group-formation and reception agencies may not transfer any quota and tourists to another group. The reception agency may not receive any tourists not formed by the group-formation agency or tourists bearing other papers. Any violators shall be handled separately.

8. Those tourists who fail to return to the mainland by the time prescribed are considered people who have overstayed in Taiwan. Those tourists who overstay in Taiwan because of force majeure - such as natural disasters, major illnesses, emergencies, abrupt incidents or public offences - the reception agency and the group-formation agency should make arrangements for them so that they can return to the mainland with other tourist groups. Those who have overstayed without a legitimate reason and the case is minor, the reception agency and the group-formation agency should make arrangements for them so that they can return to the mainland with other tourist groups. Those whose real purpose in Taiwan is not for sightseeing, whose overstay is deliberate, and whose cases are serious, the Taiwan Tourism Association and the Cross-Strait Tourism Association should contact the two sides' authorities concerned and make arrangements for their return to the mainland through other channels. In case their return must go through other necessary procedures, they shall be returned immediately following the completion of the procedures.

9. The costs incurred by any tourist's overstay and the transportation for his return to the mainland shall be borne by the tourist who has overstayed. And if he is unable to pay, the reception agency should pay the cost for him in advance. Then, within 30 days after sending back the tourist who overstayed, the agency should, with receipts of the expenses, request a reimbursement from the group-formation agency. Then the group-formation agency may press the overstayed

tourist for reimbursement. (Xinhua, 13 Jun 08, in BBC PF, 15 Jun 08; full Chinese text: RMRB, 15 Jun 08))

International Agreements

BEIJING, June 26 (Xinhua) - The Standing Committee of the National People's Congress (NPC) approved the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities at its plenary session in Beijing.

The approval of the international convention is helpful for protecting the rights of the handicapped group in China and is in conformity with the country's realities and needs, according to the NPC Foreign Affairs Committee.

In November 2001, the United Nations set up a special committee to draft the convention, and on December 13, 2006, the 61th UN General Assembly adopted the convention. On March 30, 2007, the Chinese ambassador to the United Nations signed the document on behalf of the Chinese government.

As of May 30, 129 nations and the European Union had signed the convention, while 27 nations had approved it.

The 50-clause convention is aimed! at ensuring that handicapped people enjoy the same rights and basic freedom as all other citizens.

Signing countries are asked to protect the rights of their handicapped population in economic, social and cultural fields.

China, with a population of 1.3 billion, has over 80 million people with disabilities. (XNA, 26 Jun 08)

PRC Laws and Regulations

Management Regulations on Slaughtering Live Pigs, promulgated by Decree 238 of the State Council of the People's Republic of China on December 19, 1997, and revised and adopted at the 201st executive meeting of the State Council on 19 December 2007. The regulation became effective as of 1 August 2008. (Decree No. 525 of the PRC State Council, signed by Wen Jiabao, Premier of the State Council, on 25 May 2008) (Full text: RMRB, 5 Jun 08) The regulations consist of 5 chapters with 36 articles.

Regulations on Wenchuan Post-Quake Reconstruction. The regulation became effective as of 9 June. (Decree No. 526 of the PRC State Council, signed by Wen Jiabao, Premier of the State Council, on 8 June 2008) (Full text: RMRB, 10 Jun 08) The regulations consist of 9 chapters with 80 articles.

Beijing, June 9 (Xinhua) - China promulgated the regulation on reconstruction after the May 12 Wenchuan earthquake. It was the first of its kind in the country, specially for a single massive quake, which led the reconstruction work into a legal orbit. ...

The regulation, which set guidelines for reconstruction, provided an important legal ground for the reconstruction work of various departments and quake-hit regions, said a spokesman of the Legal Affairs Office of the State Council, China's Cabinet.

He said the regulation was to ensure sound life, production, study and working conditions in quake-affected regions.

Covering nine chapters and 80 stipulations, it included the transitional settlement of quake-hit people, reconstruction planning, assessment, financing, policies, supervision and management and legal obligations.

It also put forward special requirements on earthquake-resistance levels of infrastructure construction in the quake-hit regions, including schools and hospitals.

According to the regulation, related departments should properly arrange the location of temporary housing and their supporting facilities and distribution of funds and materials.

It also made clear governments at all levels should regularly publicize the source, amount, distribution and use of relief capital and goods and receive public supervision.

Audit organs should strengthen checking over the reconstruction capital and goods and regularly make them open to the public. (XNA, 9 Jun 08)

BEIJING, May 29 (Xinhua) - Chinese authorities published a **special statute** on 29 May that provides for punishment of malpractice and fraud involving relief for the May 12 earthquake in southwest China.

The quake took at least 68,516 lives, injured 365,399 people, left another 19,350 missing and rendered more than 15 million people homeless.

The new regulation was jointly issued by the Central Commission for Discipline Inspection and the Ministry of Supervision.

The two departments ordered their local counterparts at various levels to make the anti-earthquake battle a primary task and to investigate and punish wrongdoing without hesitation.

The regulation prohibits embezzlement and fraud in the distribution of relief, the trading of relief goods, and other official malfeasance.

Institutions and individuals, leading officials in particular, who are found to have engaged in such activities will be severely punished by the Communist Party and the government.

Those who broke the law will have their cases referred to judicial departments for prosecution, it said.

As of 29 May, 37.3 billion yuan (about 5.33 billion US dollars) in cash and goods had been donated by domestic and overseas donors.

The National Audit Office (NAO) had said immediately after the May 12 earthquake that it would audit the use of cash and goods for quake disaster regions, to ensure resources were strictly managed and used in a proper and timely manner.

Auditors will investigate and deal with any attempt to hide, intercept or misappropriate donations, said the NAO. (XNA, 29 May 08)

BEIJING, May 29 (Xinhua) - China has published a statute, **Methods for Punishing Violations of Regulations on Land Management**, that replaces the "Provisional Methods for Punishing Violations of Regulations on Land Management" as of June 1.

The document was recently issued jointly by the Central Commission for Discipline Inspection (CCDI), the Ministry of Supervision (MOS), the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Security and the Ministry of Land Resources.

The new statute is the latest indication that the CCP CC and the State Council have always given priority to the issue of land use. It follows several important measures taken by the authorities to maintain order in land management.

The existing regulations have played an important role since they were enacted on March 2, 2000, but they need to be amended and improved to meet changing requirements, according to an official with the CCDI and the MOS.

China still faces a situation in which there are frequent instances of the illegal occupation of land, cultivated land in particular.

The official urged disciplinary inspection and supervision offices at different levels to seriously study and implement the new regulations and "strictly investigate and punish law-breaking and discipline-violating activities and protect cultivated land in a substantial way."

The 24-clause statute was based on the Land Management Law, the Law on Administrative Supervision, the Civil Servants Law, and the Provisions on the Punishment of Civil Servants in Administrative Departments, according to the official.

The government wants to preserve 1.8 billion mu (120 million hectares) of cultivated land, which is believed to be the base line to ensure food security for China's 1.3 billion people. (XNA, 29 May 08; full text: RMRB, 1 Jun 08)

BEIJING, June 5 (Xinhua) - Chinese President Hu Jintao, also General Secretary of the CCP CC and Chairman of the Central Military Commission, has approved **regulations on the duty of soldier committees**.

Soldier committees of the People's Liberation Army are responsible for carrying out grass-root activities, promoting military democracy and assisting Party branches.

In recent years, problems were seen in some soldier committees, such as incomplete organizations and laxness in fulfilling duties.

The regulations are aimed to ensure harmony and purity among soldiers' inner relationships and promote the army's scientific development.

Before drawing out the regulations, drafters have widely collected opinions. (XNA, 5 Jun 08; Xinhua 5 Jun 08, in BBC PF, 8 Jun 08)
